THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, CARLISLE URBAN AND RURAL AREA)(CONSOLIDATION AND MINOR AMENDMENT OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2001) (BRAMPTON) VARIATION ORDER 2003

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 1st December 2003 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Carlisle Urban and Rural Area) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2001) (Brampton) Variation Order 2003
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression "the 2001 Order" shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Carlisle Urban and Rural Area) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) Order 2001
3. The 2001 Order shall have effect as though: -

- (a) The following were added as "Schedule XXX One Way Streets – Brampton": -

<u>Street Name</u>	<u>Restriction</u>	<u>Restricted Lengths</u>
Market Place	One-way street	From its junction with Craw Hall to its junction with High Cross Street
Front Street Access Road	One way street	In a clockwise direction from its junction with Front Street for a distance of 40m.

- (b) Article 4(7) was amended to read: -

"between the hours of 8.30 am and 6.00 pm on a Monday to Saturday inclusive in the lengths of road or sides of road specified in Schedule VII to this Order: -

- (a) for a longer period than 2 hours; or
- (b) if a period of less than 2 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of road or length of road.

providing also that the driver of any vehicle shall be subject to the provisions of Articles 34(3), 38, 39, 40 and 41 to this Order in relation to the use of a parking place and the setting of parking discs".


- (c) All of the entries in Schedule XVI – Brampton “Disabled Parking Places, 24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week, Waiting Limited to 3 Hours, Return Prohibited within 1 Hour” were deleted and replaced with the following: -

<u>Street Name</u>	<u>Side of Street</u>	<u>Restricted Length</u>
Front Street (Access Road)	South side	From a point 119 metres east of the centre of its junction with Gelt Road to a point 125 metres east of the centre of the said junction
Front Street	North Side	From a point 121 metres east of the centre of its junction with Low Cross Street to a point 132 metres east of the centre of the said junction (2 bays).
Market Place	East of Moot Hall	From a point 18 metres north of its junction with Craw Hall to a point 22 metres north of the said junction.

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
