

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, CARLISLE URBAN AND RURAL AREA)(CONSOLIDATION AND MINOR AMENDMENT OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2001) VARIATION ORDER (NO. 17) 2006

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 30 October 2006 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Carlisle Urban and Rural Area) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2001) Variation Order (No. 17) Order 2006
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression "the 2001 Order" shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Carlisle Urban and Rural Area) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) Order 2001
3. The 2001 Order shall have effect as though: -

- (a) The following were added as to Schedule XXXIII Prohibition of Entry/Driving – Carlisle": -

| <u>Street Name</u> | <u>Restricted Length</u> |
|------------------------------|---|
| Catholic Lonning Carlisle | From its junction with Strand Road/Lismore Place extending in an easterly then northerly direction for a distance of 220 metres |

- (b) The following was added as Article 33(4): -

33. (4) Nothing in Article 32 shall apply so as to prevent vehicles proceeding along Catholic Lonning, Carlisle, which are being used: -
 - (a) to enable goods or merchandise to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (b) for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes, or a vehicle (other than a passenger vehicle) in the service of a local authority or water authority which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (d) by statutory undertakers or their contractors in connection with any building operation or demolition, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair, in or near the roads of any sewer or of any main,

pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;

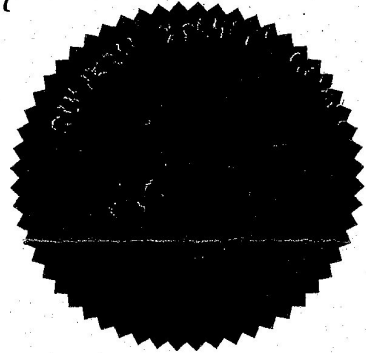
- (e) in connection with the removal of a coffin containing the remains of a deceased person to or from premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road; or
- (f) to gain access to or from premises on or adjacent to the said lengths of road which can only reasonably be reached from the restricted lengths of road.

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
