

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, DISTRICT OF EDEN) (CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2003) VARIATION ORDER (NO.2) (PART 2 OF 2) 2004

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 3rd May 2004 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, District of Eden) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2003) Variation Order (No. 2) (Part 2 of 2) Order 2004
- 2. For the purposes of this Order the expression "the 2003 Order" shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, District of Eden) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2003
- 3. The 2003 Order shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) The following entry in Schedule 39 Part A Penrith "Parking for Disabled and Permit Holders B Only At All Times" was deleted: -

"Arthur Street South East

From a point 15m NE of its

320m 47m

junction with Meeting House Lane to a point 327m SE of that junction"

and replaced with the following: -

"Arthur Street East

From a point 17m north of its

320m 50m

junction with Meeting House Lane

to a point 337m north of that

junction".

(b) The following entry in Schedule 39 Part A Penrith "Parking for Disabled and Permit Holders B Only – At All Times" was deleted: -

"Arthur Street North West

From a point 212m NE of its

170m 41m

junction with Meeting House Lane to a point 356m SE of that junction (including provision for parking

part on footway)

and replaced with the following: -

"Arthur Street West

From a point 192m north of its 170m 43m junction with Meeting House Lane to a point 362m north of that junction".

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
