- 2. The Order will come into operation on 13 April 2015 and its effect will be to remove the "Disc Parking Places, 8.30 am 6 pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive, Waiting Limited to 1 Hour, Return Prohibited within 1 Hour, Residents of Zone C Exempt" restriction on the north side of Back Corporation Road (ie. the area between Back Corporation Road and Castle Way).

NB: Carlisle City Council will be incorporating this area into their Off-Street Parking Order. Carlisle City Council has confirmed that their Off-Street Order will contain an exemption for residents of Zone C to the waiting restrictions and that they are not proposing to charge a fee for parking in this area, as is presently the case within the County Council's Order.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks of 2 April 2015 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
