HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE HERTFORDSHIRE (STATION ROAD AND BEGGARS LANE,
TRING STATION, ALDBURY)
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1993

The Hertfordshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section[s] 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984.

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 13 September 1993 and may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Station Road and Beggars Lane, Tring Station, Aldbury) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1993".
- 2. (1) In this Order

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as the Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984.

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984.

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specifications for Parking Discs (BS No. 4631: 1970), coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins; and "relevant position" means

- i) A vehicle displays a disabled person's badge issued before 2 March 1992 in the relevant position if:
 - a) in the case of vehicle fitted with a front windscreen,
 the badge is exhibited thereon on the near side of and
 immediately behind the windscreen and with its front
 facing forward so as to be legible from outside the
 vehicle; or
 - b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.
- ii) A vehicle displays a disabled person's badge issued on or after 2 March 1992 in the relevant position if:
 - a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle; or

- b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.
- iii) A vehicle displays a parking disc in the relevant position
 if:
 - a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or facia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; or
 - b) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, no person shall, except under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause of permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon Monday to Friday inclusive in the lengths of Station Road and Beggars Lane, specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 5. (1) Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit vehicle to wait in the length of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable;
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
 - (i) building, industrial and demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (v) to a vehicle being used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (c) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953.
- (2) Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle in the length of road specified in Schedule to this Order at any time on any day.
- 6. Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the length of road referred to in the said Article for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
- 7. The provisions of The Hertfordshire (Station Road and Beggars Lane, Tring) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1985 are hereby revoked.
- 8. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

Lengths of roads at Aldbury, Hertfordshire

SCHEDULE 1

No waiting at any time

Station Road - south east side

from a point 231 metres south west of its junction with Northfield Road south westwards for a distance of 59 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

Waiting prohibited Monday to Friday 10.00 a.m. to 12 noon

Station Road

(i) - north west side from its junction with Northfield Road south westwards for a distance of 550 metres.

- (ii) south east side
- (a) from its junction with Northfield Road south westwards for a distance of 231 metres.
 - (b) from a point 387 metres south west of its junction with Northfield Road south westwards for a distance of 163 metres.

Beggars Lane

from its junction with Station Road southwards for a distance of 30 metres.
