THE HERTFORDSHIRE (HIGH STREET CAR PARK UN-NAMED ACCESS, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES EXCEPT FOR ACCESS) ORDER 2012

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (High Street Car Park Un-Named Access, Hemel Hempstead) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles except for Access) Order 2012" and shall come into operation on Tuesday 29 April 2014.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 to this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or be in that length of un-named road that connects High Street Car Park with that length of the access road leading to the rear of no's 62 to 100 High Street.
 - In this Order the expression 'Motor Vehicle' shall have the same meaning as given in Section 136 of the Act of 1984
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 to this Order shall apply in respect of any motor vehicle being used for legitimate access to the rear of no's 62 to 100 (evens) High Street.
- 4. In accordance with Section 92 of the said Act of 1984 upon the coming into operation of this Order, barriers will be placed across that length road specified in Article 2 of this Order.
- 5. The Hertfordshire County Council in making this Order are satisfied that this Order is required to avoid the likelihood of danger to persons using the road adjoining that length of road specified in Article 2 of this Order.
- 6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
