Dacorum Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 19 of The Local Government Act 2000 and The Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with the Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of powers conferred on that County under sections 1, 2, 4 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the provisions of Part 6 and Schedule 9 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officers of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on 2 June 2014 and may be cited as "The Borough of Dacorum (Restriction of Goods Vehicles) (Hemel Hempstead) Order 2013"
2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description;

(2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
3. No person shall cause any goods vehicle the weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to wait between 7pm and 12 midnight and between 12 midnight and 7am on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and at any time on Saturdays and Sundays in Two Waters Road, Hemel Hempstead.
