STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

THE HERTFORDSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2015

The Hertfordshire County Council is proposing to improve road safety by implementing new waiting restrictions in various parts of Hemel Hempstead.

The proposed restrictions include:

- 'No waiting at any time' on parts of London Road, Anchor Lane, Reson Way, Long Chaulden, Paddock Way, Lucks Hill, Gadebridge Road, Laureate Way, Crawley Drive, Washington Avenue and Lomond Road.
- 'No stopping or waiting 8.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday, during school term times, on the School Keep Clear Markings' on parts of Bennetts End Road, Cambrian Way and Fletcher Way.
- 'No waiting, loading or unloading 8.30am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday' on part of Newfield Lane.
- 'No waiting 8.15am to 9.15am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm Monday to Friday' on part of Long Chaulden (service road fronting Chaulden Community Centre).

The proposed measures are being introduced with the intention of addressing safety and access concerns that have arisen due to current on road parking habits at the various locations in Hemel Hempstead. It is intended that the restrictions will improve the visibility of vehicles / pedestrians using the roads.

Therefore, it appears to the Highway Authority that it is necessary and expedient to make Order in the interests of avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger and for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

The proposal has been subject to consultation with local and County Councillors representing the area and Dacorum Borough Council. The local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, Hertfordshire County Council Passenger Transport Unit and local residents have also been consulted.

Deferment of part of the Original proposals.

The below aspects of the original proposals published on 14 January 2015 associated with this scheme are deferred pending further procedural consideration and decisions by the Highway Authority:

THE HERTFORDSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2015

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Various Roads, Hemel Hempstead) (Prohibition of Stopping and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2015" and shall come into effect on Monday 27 July 2015.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 6, 7 and 8(1) of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in those lengths of London Road, Anchor Lane, Reson Way, Long Chaulden, Paddock Way, Lucks Hill, Gadebridge Road, Laureate Way, Crawley Drive, Washington Avenue and Lomond Road, Hemel Hempstead as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3(1) Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait between the hours of 8,00am to 5,00pm Monday to Friday during school term time on the School Keep Clear markings in those lengths of Bennetts End Road, Cambrian Way and Fletcher Way, Hemel Hempstead as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- (2) In this Article:- "school term time" has the meaning as those days of the year which have been determined by the education authority as school days in accordance with the provisions of Section 32 of The Education Act 2002.
- 4. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload between the hours of 8.30am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday on that length of Newfield Lane, Hemel Hempstead as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
- 5. Save as provided in Articles 6, 7 and 8(2) of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.15am to 9.15am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm Monday to Friday on that length of Long Chaulden (Service road fronting Chaulden Community Centre), Hemel Hempstead as specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.
- 6(1) Nothing in Articles 2, 3, 4 and 5 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by those Articles (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") in relation to –
 - (a) a vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform; or with permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by Dacorum Borough Council.
 - (c) a vehicle which is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or which has stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property or when required to do so by law;
 - (d) a vehicle which is stationary in order that it may be used for one or more of the purposes specified in sub-Article (2) of this Article and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose without stopping in the restricted area;
 - (e) a marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be delivered or collected;

In this Article -

The expressions "universal service provider", "provision of a universal postal Service" and "postal packet" shall bear the same meanings as in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011.

- (2) The "purposes" referred to in sub-Article (1)(d) of this Article are -
 - (a) any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;
 - (b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (c) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
 - (d) constructing, improving, maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture; or
 - (e) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.
- 7. Nothing in Articles 2 or 5 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by those Articles (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") so as to render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait only for so long as may be reasonably necessary
 - (a) to enable goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle from or to premises adjacent to the restricted area; or
 - (b) to enable a passenger to board or alight and to load and unload any luggage.
- 8(1) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
 - (2) Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 of this Order.
 - (3) In this Article -
 - "disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984;
 - "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 3(1) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000
 - "parking disc" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 8(5) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000; and
 - "relevant position" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 4 of The Local Authorities' Traffic
- 9. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 10. The provisions of the following Order are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order:
 - The Dacorum District Council (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (No 3) Order 1981
- 11. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

London Road (south west side)

from a point 15 metres north west of a point in line with the south east boundary of Moores Motorcycles north westwards for 10 metres.

(north east side)

- (a) from a point 1 metre south east of a point in line with the south east boundary of Moores Motor Cycles south eastwards for approximately 50 metres to a point 21 metres north west of a point in line with the boundary between 27 and 28 Shendish Edge.
- (b) from a point 19 metres south east of a point in line with the boundary between 20 and 23 Shendish Edge south eastwards and eastwards for approximately 75 metres to its junction with the north west kerbline of the entrance to Doolittle Meadows Industrial Estate.

Anchor Lane (north west side)

- (a) from a point in line with the projected south west kerbline of Reson Way south westwards for approximately 7.5 metres to a point 3.5 metres north east of a point in line with the boundary between 122 and 124 Anchor Lane.

- Gadebridge Road (a) from a point in line with the projected north east kerbline of Laureate Way north eastwards for approximately 15 metres to a point 7 metres south west of a point in line with the boundary between 92 and 94 Gadebridge Road.

Laureate Way (both sides)
