NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council has made Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to introduce waiting restrictions, limited waiting parking places and verge parking facilities in Tring as specified in the Schedules to this Notice. The Orders will come into effect on Monday 21 December 2015.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders, or of any provision contained in them, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may within 6 weeks from the date of this Notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

**SCHEDULE 1:** No waiting at any time – those sections of road herein listed and as set out in the Order and accompanying plans – Parts of Station Road, Clarkes Spring, Dundale Road, Meadow Close, St Peters Hill, Plaiters Close, Park Road, Park Street, Hastoe Lane, Windmill Way, Miswell Lane, Highfield Road, Beaconsfield Road, Longfield Road, Goldfield Road, Western Road and Cobbetts Ride.

**SCHEDULE 2:** Parking Place – limited to 30 minutes waiting, no return within 2 hours - effective 8.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Friday – that section of road herein listed and as set out in the Order and accompanying plans – Part of Miswell Lane.

**SCHEDULE 3:** Parking Places – limited to 3 hours waiting, no return within 2 hours - effective 8.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday – those sections of road herein listed and as set out in the Order and accompanying plans – Parts of Western Road.

**SCHEDULE 4:** Verge Parking Place for use at any time – effecting that section of road herein listed and as set out in the Order and accompanying plans – Part of Beggars Lane.

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING**

### **THE HERTFODSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, TRING) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2015**

### **THE HERTFORDSHIRE (MISWELL LANE AND WESTERN ROAD, TRING) (PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2015**

### **THE HERTFORDSHIRE (BEGGARS LANE, TRING) (VERGE PARKING PLACE) ORDER 2015**

Hertfordshire County Council is proposing to introduce new waiting and parking restrictions in parts of Tring.

The proposals will comprise of –

- 'No waiting at any time' restrictions on parts of Station Road, Clarkes Spring, Dundale Road, Meadow Close, St Peters Hill, Plaiters Close, Park Road, Park Street, Hastoe Lane, Windmill Way, Miswell Lane, Highfield Road, Beaconsfield Road, Longfield Road, Goldfield Road, Western Road and Cobbetts Ride.
- Provisions of a '30 minutes limited waiting no return within 2 hours Monday to Friday 8.00am to 6.00pm parking place' on part of Miswell Lane.
- Provision of '3 hours limited waiting no return within 2 hours Monday to Saturday 8.00am to 6.00pm parking place' on parts of Western Road.
- Provision of a 'Grass crete verge parking place' on part of Beggars Lane.

Measures are to address safety and access concerns due to current on road parking habits at various locations. The waiting restrictions and parking places are due to be implemented in order to aid visibility and access of vehicles at various locations, prevent or relieve congestion by introducing stop and shop along Western Road and Miswell Lane as well as introducing parking on grass crete at Beggars Lane.

Therefore, it appears to the Highway Authority that it is necessary and expedient to make the Orders in the interests of; avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs; and for preventing or relieving congestion.

The proposal has been subject to consultation with local and County Councillors representing the area and Dacorum Borough Council. The local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, Tring Town Council have also been consulted.

### THE HERTFORDSHIRE (BEGGARS LANE, TRING) (VERGE PARKING PLACE) ORDER 2015

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. (1) This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Beggars Lane, Tring) (Verge Parking Place) Order 2015" and shall come into effect on Monday 21 December 2015.
- (2) The Hertfordshire (Beggars Lane, Tring) (Verge Parking Place) Plan numbered HC-GMSC016.Y2 Sheet 07 (hereinafter referred to as "the Verge Parking Place Plan") is incorporated into this Order.
2. That length of verge in Beggars Lane, Tring as specified in the Schedule to this Order and shown as a shaded area on "the Verge Parking Place Plan" (which is incorporated into this Order) is hereby designated for use as parking place for motor vehicles at any time.
3. Where in Article 2 of this Order a length of verge in Beggars Lane, Tring is described as designated for use as a parking place motor vehicles at any time, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle to wait in that parking place unless it is wholly parked within the grass-crete treated area of the parking place, as shown on plan HC-G-MS016.Y2 Sheet 07 and indicated in the key to that plan.
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
5. A vehicle left in a Parking Place in contravention of Articles 2 or 3 of this Order or otherwise in accordance with the provisions of this Order shall incur a penalty charge.
6. The provisions of the following Order shall be revoked but only in so far as they shall no longer effect that part of the verge as specified in Article 2 to this Order and as shown and indicated on the key to the Verge Parking Place Plan as a designated verge parking place -

7. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the act of 1984 or by any other enactment.

#### SCHEDULE

##### Length of Beggars Lane, Tring – designated verge parking place at any time

Beggars Lane (south west side)	that section of south west verge at a width of 2.60 metres throughout, from a point 26.5 metres south east of a point in line with the south east kerbline of Station Road south eastwards for 23 metres.

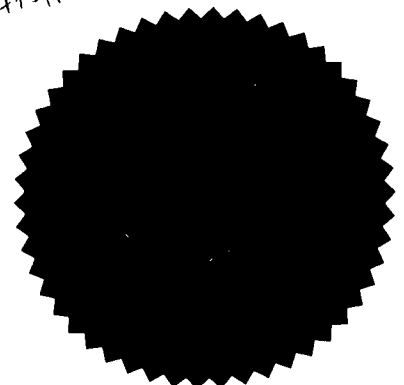

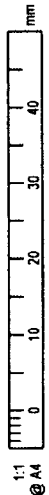
