NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to amend The Hertfordshire (High Street, Hemel Hempstead) (Restricted Zone) Order 2012 so as to introduce a limited waiting parking bay as specified in the Schedule to this Notice. The amendment Order will come into effect on Monday 27 February 2017.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from the date of this Notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING
THE HERTFORDSHIRE (HIGH STREET, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD)
(RESTRICTED ZONE) ORDER 2012 (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2016

Hertfordshire County Council is proposing to improve road safety by making an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to amend the existing Restricted Zone Order effecting High Street, Hemel Hempstead to enable the introduction a new limited waiting parking bay.

The effect of the Amendment Order will be to introduce –

- 1 hour parking bay no return within 2 hours 8.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday inclusive, on the south western side of High Street in the vicinity of No's 48 to 54.

Hertfordshire County Council is undertaking a highway scheme to convert the existing bus layby to a public parking bay. There are a number of conflicting and safety issues taking place in this area that have been brought to the attention of the Highways Engineers. The main problem at present is that vehicles are frequently parking within the bus layby and conflicts are arising between parked vehicles and bus services.

The scheme is proposed to improve the existing situation by providing short stay parking bay to improve the access to the shops for vehicles and prevent a likelihood of danger arising to road users as a result of conflicts between parked vehicles and bus services. Buses will be required to stop briefly within the carriageway for drop / pick up services.

This will enable vehicles to park without obstructing existing bus services.

Therefore, it appears to the Highway Authority that it is necessary and expedient to make Order in the interests of; avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

The proposal has been subject to consultation with local and County Councillors representing the area and Dacorum Borough Council. The local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, Hertfordshire County Council Passenger Transport Unit, local bus companies, businesses and residents have also been consulted.

**THE HERTFORDSHIRE (HIGH STREET, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD)
(RESTRICTED ZONE) ORDER 2012 (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2016**

The Hertfordshire County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as the Act of 1984) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, has made the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (High Street, Hemel Hempstead) (Restricted Zone) Order 2012 (Amendment No 1) Order 2016" and shall come into effect on Monday 27 February 2017.
2. The Hertfordshire (High Street, Hemel Hempstead) (Restricted Zone) Order 2012, hereinafter referred to as "the 2012 Order", shall be amended as follows;
(a) the Map Schedule specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall be removed from "the 2012 Order"; and
(b) the Map Schedule specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall be inserted into "the 2012 Order".
3. The effect of the Order will be to introduce a Parking Bay effective between 8.00am and 6.00pm Monday to Saturday inclusive, limited to 1 hour waiting within no return within the next 2 hours, on the south west side of High Street, Hemel Hempstead from a point 3 metres north west of a point in line with the south east facia wall of No 48 High Street, north westwards for 24 metres to a point 1.5 metres north west of a point in line the boundary between 54 and 56 High Street.
