

DACORUM BOROUGH COUNCIL
PAY & DISPLAY PARKING CHARGES IN
WATERHOUSE STREET, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT DACORUM BOROUGH COUNCIL, pursuant to arrangements made with Hertfordshire County Council under section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangements for Discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000, and in exercise of the powers conferred on that County under section 46A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, are going to increase the charges for parking a vehicle in the pay and display parking places in Waterhouse Street, Hemel Hempstead.

The charges that currently apply and the new charges that will apply from 15th June 2015 are as follows:

Parking Period	Current charges	New charges from 15th June 2015
Up to 15 minutes	£0.25	£0.50
15 to 30 minutes	£0.50	£1.00

The charges described above apply between 8 am and 6 pm on Mondays to Saturdays. Parking will continue to be free of charge between 6 pm and 8 am on the following day on Mondays to Saturdays and all day on Sundays.

The existing tariff, introduced in 2003, is being revised in order to bring the on-street parking charges above those charged in the public car parks. This is to encourage drivers to park in the off-street car parks rather than on-street therefore providing increased parking opportunities for customers requiring shorter periods to shop. It is anticipated that this will be to the advantage of both the local businesses and their customers.
