#### STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

# THE HERTFODSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2016

Hertfordshire County Council is proposing to improve road safety by introducing new waiting restrictions in Hemel Hempstead.

The proposals will comprise of -

 'No waiting at any time' restrictions in parts of Wood Crescent, Fern Drive, Crabtree Lane, Crabtree Close, St Albans Hill, Risedale Road, Belmont Road, Glebe Close, Chambersbury Lane and Market Oak Lane

These measures are proposed to address safety and access concerns that have arisen due to current on road parking habits at various locations. The Highway Authority is considering waiting restrictions in order to aid visibility and access of vehicles at various locations in Hemel Hempstead.

Therefore, it appears to the Highway Authority that it is necessary and expedient to make Order in the interests of; avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

The proposal has been subject to consultation with local and County Councillors representing the area and Dacorum Borough Council. The local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, Hertfordshire County Council Passenger Transport Unit and Nash Mills Parish Council have also been consulted.

# THE HERTFORDSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2016

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Various Roads, Hemel Hempstead) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 2016" and shall come into effect on Monday 31 October 2016.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in those lengths of road in Hemel Hempstead as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. (1) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by that Article (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") in relation to
  - (a) a vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
  - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform; or with permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by Dacorum Borough Council.
  - (c) a vehicle which is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or which has stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property or when required to do so by law;
  - (d) a vehicle which is stationary in order that it may be used for one or more of the purposes specified in sub-Article (2) of this Article and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose without stopping in the restricted area;
  - (e) a marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be delivered or collected;

In this Article -

The expressions "universal service provider", "provision of a universal postal Service" and "postal packet" shall bear the same meanings as in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011.

- (2) The "purposes" referred to in sub-Article (1)(d) of this Article are -
  - (a) any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;
  - (b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (c) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
  - (d) constructing, improving, maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture; or
  - (e) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.
- 4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by that Article (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") so as to render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait only for so long as may be reasonably necessary –

- (a) to enable goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle from or to premises adjacent to the restricted area; or
- (b) to enable a passenger to board or alight and to load and unload any luggage.
- 5. (1) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule of this Order for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
  - (2) In this Article -

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 3(1) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

"parking disc" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 8(5) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000; and

"relevant position" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 4 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

- 6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 7. The provisions of the following Order are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order:

The Borough of Dacorum (Controlled Parking Zones) Order 2013

8. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

#### **SCHEDULE**

#### lengths of road in Hemel Hempstead - no waiting at any time

### Wood Crescent (north east side)

- (a) from a point in line with the projected north west kerbline of Fern Drive north westwards for approximately 15.5 metres to a point 0.25 metres south east of a point in line with the boundary between 27 and 29 Wood Crescent.
- (b) from a point in line with the projected south east kerbline of Fern Drive south eastwards for approximately 18 metres to a point 2 metres north west of a point in line with the boundary between 35 and 37 Wood Crescent.

### Fern Drive (both sides)

from its junction with the north east kerbline of Wood Crescent north eastwards for approximately 10 metres to a point 4 metres south west of a point in line with the south west facia wall of 33 Wood Crescent.

### Crabtree Lane (north west side)

- a) from a point in line with the projected south west kerbline of Crabtree Close south westwards for approximately 12 metres to a point 4.5 metres north east of a point in line with the boundary between 11 and 13 Crabtree Lane.
- (b) from a point in line with the projected north east kerbline of Crabtree Close north eastwards for approximately 12.5 metres to a point 5 metres south west of a point in line with the boundary between 19 and 21 Crabtree Lane.

# Crabtree Close (both sides)

from its junction with the north west kerbline of Crabtree Lane north westwards for approximately 10 metres to a point 2.5 metres north west of a point in line with the south east facia wall of 15 Crabtree Lane.

### St'Albans Hill (south east side)

- (a) from a point in line with the projected north east kerbline of Risedale Road north eastwards for approximately 15 metres to a point 8 metres south west of a point in line with the north east boundary of 76 St Albans Hill.
- (b) from a point in line with the projected south west kerbline of Risedale Road south westwards for approximately 15 metres to a point 0.25 metres south west of a point in line with the boundary between 72 and 74 St Albans Hill.

### Risedale Road (both sides)

from its junction with the south east kerbline of St Albans Hill south eastwards for approximately 11 metres to a point 6 metres north west of a point in line with the south east facia wall of 74 St Albans Hill.

## Belmont Road (south east side)

- (a) from a point in line with the projected north east kerbline of Glebe Close north eastwards for approximately 13 metres to a point in line with the boundary between 12 and 14 Belmont Road.
- (b) from a point in line with the projected south west kerbline of Glebe Close south westwards for approximately 9.5 metres to a point 5.25 metres north east of a point in line with the boundary between 6 and 8 Belmont Road.

### Glebe Close (both sides)

from its junction with the south east kerbline of Belmont Road south eastwards for approximately 10 metres to a point 5 metres north west of a point in line with the south east facia wall of 12 Belmont Road.

(north east & north west sides)

from a point 3 metres south east of a point in line with the boundary between 3 and 5 Glebe Close south eastwards and north eastwards for approximately 32 metres to a point 1.5 metres south west of a point in line with the boundary between 24 and 26 Glebe Close.

Chambersbury Lane (east and south east sides)

from a point 9.5 metres north of a point in line with the boundary between 148 and 150 Chambersbury Lane north and north eastwards for approximately 27 metres to a point 3 south west of a point in line with the boundary between 154 and 156 Chambersbury Lane.

(north west side)

from a point in line with the projected north east kerbline of Market Oak Lane north eastwards for approximately 43 metres to a point 7 metres north east of a point in line with the north east facia wall of 51 Market Oak Lane.

Market Oak Lane (east side)

from a point in line with the projected south kerbline of Chambersbury Lane northwards for approximately 18 metres to a point 2 metres south of a point in line with the boundary between 47 and 49 Market Oak Lane.
