

**DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS
(AMENDMENT NO.3) ORDER 2022**

Darlington Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act and of the Traffic Management Act 2004 hereby make the following Order.

CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2019**


1. The Darlington Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2019 ('the Off Street Parking Places Order 2019') is amended as follows:
 - 1.1 The definition of "electric vehicle" set out in article 2 of the Off Street Parking Places Order 2019 is deleted and replaced by the article set out in Schedule One to this Order
 - 1.2 Article 8 of the Off Street Parking Places Order 2019 is deleted and replaced by the article set out in Schedule Two to this Order
 - 1.3 Article 59(6) of the Off Street Parking Places Order 2019 is deleted

**PART 2
GENERAL**

2. This Order is entitled the Darlington Borough Council Road Traffic Restrictions (Amendment No.3) Order 2022 and shall come into effect on the 24th June 2022
3. All other provisions of the Off Street Parking Places Order 2019 not affected by this Order will continue in full force and effect

SCHEDULE ONE

**ADDED TO ARTICLE 2
OFF STREET PARKING PLACES ORDER 2019**

“electric vehicle” means any vehicle as herein defined which is propelled entirely or partially by electricity and is capable of being charged from an external source

SCHEDULE TWO

ADDED TO OFF STREET PARKING PLACES ORDER 2019

8.

(1) No person shall cause a vehicle to be left in an electric vehicle charging space at any time unless it is an electric vehicle; and

(2) No person shall cause or permit an electric vehicle to be left in an electric vehicle charging space if it is not being charged
