

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, DARTFORD)
(PROHIBITION OF LOADING) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2009
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

Interpretation

(1) In this Order:-

"junction"	except where otherwise specified, means the intersection point of the nearest projected kerblines of the adjoining roads specified
"owner" and "traffic sign"	have the same meanings as in Section 142 of the Act of 1984
"parking exemption certificate"	a certificate or other means of identification which has been issued by the local traffic authority or its appointed agents on which is shown the index number of the vehicle to which it has been issued and <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) a commencement date and time2) an expiry date and time3) or both and4) may specify those roads or parts thereof in which the certificate is valid
"relevant position"	means in the case of a parking exemption certificate, in a conspicuous position inside the vehicle so as the certificate is visible in full and legible from outside the vehicle.
"specified road"	means the road or roads specified in the Schedules to this Order.
"weekday"	means any day of the week except Sunday

Prohibition of loading

- (2) Save as provided in Articles (3) and (4) of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load or unload in any of the lengths of road specified in any Schedule listed in Column 1 of Table 1 to this order, during the times relating to that Schedule as specified in Column 2.
- (3) Nothing in Article (2) of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-
- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable the vehicle to be used as part of a funeral cortege or a wedding procession;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such a purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of any local authority or with the permission of any such authority in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose elsewhere, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the carrying out of any road works or the laying, erection and alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports; or
 - (e) to enable the vehicle to be used for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes.

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- (4) Nothing in Articles (2) of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a parking exemption certificate to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order provided the certificate has been issued for the vehicle displaying it and is valid for the place where the vehicle is waiting and for both the day and time when the vehicle is waiting.

- (5) Where the provisions of this Order conflict with any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984 and being in effect on the date this order is made, the provisions of this order shall prevail except that any order for the provision of a disabled person's parking bay shall prevail over any provisions made under this order in so far as they affect the provision of the said disabled person's parking bay. No provision of this order shall be in derogation of a bus stop clearway marked in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

Revocations

- (6) Each of the Orders specified in the Schedule of Revocations to this order, are hereby revoked to the extent that their provisions have been consolidated in this Order.

Citation and Commencement

- (7) This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dartford) (Prohibition of Loading) Consolidation Order 2009" and shall come into operation on the 28th September 2009.
