ORDER 2012**

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER ACT 1984

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1) and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

In the Articles to the Order;

1. Schedule 1 - No waiting any time
2. Schedule 2 - No waiting 6.00pm to 6.00am the following day every day (7 days)

In the Schedules to the Order

The following items to be inserted in the first Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence.

**Schedule 1
(No waiting at any time)**

Einnie Road	Both sides entire length.
Halcrow Avenue	Both sides entire length.
Littlebrook Manor Way	On both sides from the junction with Bob Dunn Way to the junction with Rennie Drive.
Marsh Street	On both sides from the junction with Bob Dunn Way to the entrance to longreach Sewage Works.
Rennie Drive	On both sides from the junction with Littlebrook Manor Way to the junction with Marsh Street.

The following item to be inserted in the second Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence.

**Schedule 2
(No waiting 6.00pm to 6.00am every day)**

Brunel Way	Both sides for its entire length.
