THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DARTFORD)

(PROVISION OF PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2009

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 4, 32, 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

Interpretation

"disabled persons vehicle"

has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1991 or the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"disabled persons badge"

has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1991 or the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000;

"driver"

in relation to a vehicle waiting in a street parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"junction"

except where otherwise specified, means the intersection point of the nearest projected kerblines, of the adjoining roads specified;

"motor car"

means any vehicle which is classified as private light goods for road fund licensing purposes;

"owner" and "traffic sign"

have the same meanings as in Section 142 of the Act of 1984;

"parking disc"

means a disc, issued by a Local Authority, 125mm in diameter coloured either blue or orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins;

"parking exemption certificate"

a certificate or other means of identification which has been issued by the local traffic authority or its appointed agents on which is shown the index number of the vehicle to which it has been issued and

- 1) a commencement date and time
- 2) an expiry date and time
- 3) or both and

4) may specify those roads or parts thereof in which the certificate is valid

"parking permit"

means the certificate issued by the Council from time to time that authorises a vehicle left in a parking place subject to the provisions of this Order;

"parking place"

means any area of land or length of road specified in column (1) of the Schedule to this Order provided by the Council under Section 32 of the Act of 1984 for use as a parking place;

"parking ticket"

means the ticket issued by a ticket parking meter on payment of the specified charge;

"parking ticket meter means an apparatus installed in the vicinity of one of the parking places controlled by this order, of a type and design approved by the Secretary of State for the purposes of this order, being apparatus designed to issue numbered tickets on the payment of a specified charge

The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dartford) (Provision of Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2009

"relevant position" means;

- in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or face panel, the disabled persons badge is exhibited thereon so that Part I of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle;
- 2) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or face panel, the disabled persons badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part I of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle;
- 3) in the case of a parking permit, parking ticket or parking exemption certificate, in a conspicuous position inside the vehicle so as the permit, ticket or certificate is visible in full and legible view from outside the vehicle.

"specified charge"

means the charge as set by the Council from time to time for parking in a designated parking place where charges apply;

"specified road"

means the road or roads specified in the Schedules to this Order;

"weekday"

means any day of the week except Sunday.

- (2) Each area of land or length of road specified in the Schedules to this Order is authorised for use as a parking place for such classes of vehicles as are specified in Article (3) (a) subject to being parked in the manner described in Article (3) (b).
- (3) Where in the Schedules to this Order a parking place is described, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place unless it is:-
 - a motor car, invalid carriage, a motorcycle, any other vehicle not exceeding 1.5 tonnes unladen weight or unless stated in the Schedule to this Order to be a parking place for another class of vehicle; and
 - (b) wholly within the limits of the marked bay.
- (4) Save as provided for in the following provisions of this Order, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any parking place in the lengths of road specified in any Schedule listed in Column 1 of Tables 1,2,3,4,5 or 6 to this Order, during the permitted hours relating to that Schedule as specified in Column 2 of the respective Table.

PERMIT PARKING

(5)

- (a) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a parking permit to wait in the lengths of road specified in any Schedule listed in Column 1 of Table 1 during the permitted hours relating to that Schedule as specified in Column 2 provided that no vehicle shall, except in an emergency upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, wait in that parking place:
 - (i) for a longer period of time than that listed in Column 3 of Table 1 relating to that Schedule in the Table; and
 - (ii) if a period of time less than that specified in Column 4 of Table 1 relating to that Schedule has elapsed since the termination during the permitted hours of the last period of waiting by that vehicle on the same road.

- (b) The terms of issue of Parking Permits shall be as published from time to time by the Council.
- (c) When parked in accordance with the terms of this Order, the parking permit shall be displayed in the relevant position throughout the permitted hours.
- (d) If the parking permit is mutilated or defaced or the figures or particulars on it become illegible the parking permit holder shall surrender it to the Council and may apply for the issue of a duplicate parking permit for which an administration charge may be made.
- (e) On issue of a duplicate permit the original permit shall become invalid.
- (f) The Council may withdraw a parking permit at any time if any requirements of this Order are not complied with.

PARKING FOR PAYMENT

(6)

- (a) Subject to the following provisions of Articles 7 to 10, the lengths of road specified in any Schedule listed in Column 1 of Table 2 are authorised to be used as parking places for vehicles, on such days and during such hours as identified in Column 2 of Table 2 for the related Schedule, upon payment of the specified charge for parking in the manner set in this Order. Provided that no person shall, except in an emergency upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place identified in the said Schedules:
 - (i) for longer than either the maximum period for waiting specified in Column 3 of Table 2 relating to that Schedule or until the expiration of the period for which the specified charge for parking has been paid, whichever occurs earlier; and
 - (ii) if a period of time less than that specified in Column 4 of Table 2 relating to that Schedule has elapsed since the termination during the permitted hours of the last period of waiting by that vehicle on the same road.

(7) Amount and Method of Payment of the Specified Charge and Display of Tickets

- (a) Save as provided in Articles 14 to 16 of this Order the specified charge for a vehicle left in a parking place during the permitted hours as listed in Column 2 of Table 2 in relation to that Schedule shall be in accordance with fees and charges as advertised from time to time by the Council and shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in the parking place by the insertion into the ticket parking meter of coins to a value not less than the specified charge.
- (b) Upon payment of the specified charge the driver shall exhibit in the relevant position on the vehicle the ticket issued by the ticket parking meter.

(8) Installation of Ticket Parking Meters at Parking Places

The Council may -

- (a) install in the vicinity of a parking place such ticket parking meters as are required by this Order for the purpose of that parking place; and
- (b) carry out such other work as is authorised by this Order or is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place
- (c) on any closing or suspension of use of the parking places in accordance with the provisions of Article 21 of this Order, or in the event of the ticket parking meter requiring repair, temporarily remove the ticket parking meter and any post, bracket or other support on which the said ticket parking meter is fitted.

(9) Indications by Parking Meter Tickets

(a) The numbered ticket issued by the ticket parking meter shall indicate the day and time of payment of the charge, and the part of the vehicle's registration as entered by the driver.

(10) Indications by Parking Meter Tickets as Evidence

- (a) If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place during the permitted hours:
 - (i) no ticket is exhibited on that vehicle in accordance with Article 7; or
 - (ii) the indication of the vehicle's registration upon the ticket does not accord with the vehicle on which the ticket is exhibited

it shall be presumed unless the contrary is proved that the specified charge has not been duly paid.

(b) If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place during the permitted hours a civil enforcement officer or any other person duly authorised by the Council considers that the ticket exhibited on the vehicle indicates that the period for which the specified charge has been paid has expired, it shall be presumed that the specified charge has been duly paid but the period for which payment was made by the specified charge has expired.

SPACES FOR SPECIFIC ROAD USERS

(11) Loading Bays

- (a) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle of the class specified in Article 3 to wait in the lengths of road specified in any Schedule listed in Column 1 of Table 3 on such days and during such hours as specified in Column 2 of Table 3 for the related Schedule. Provided that no person shall, except in an emergency upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place identified in the said Schedules:
 - (i) for longer than either the maximum period for waiting specified in Column 3 of Table 3 relating to that Schedule; and
 - (ii) if a period of time less than that specified in Column 4 of Table 3 relating to that Schedule has elapsed since the termination during the permitted hours of the last period of waiting by that vehicle on the same road.

(12) Taxi Only Bays

(a) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to stop or wait in the lengths of road specified in any Schedule listed in Column 1 of Table 4 on such days and during such hours as specified in Column 2 of Table 4 for the related Schedule provided that the vehicle is a Licensed Taxi.

(13) Disabled Badge Holders Bays

- (a) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge to wait in the lengths of road specified in any Schedule listed in Column 1 of Table 5 on such days and during such hours as specified in Column 2 of Table 5 for the related Schedule. Provided that no person shall, except in an emergency upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place identified in the said Schedules:
 - (i) for longer than either the maximum period for waiting specified in Column 3 of Table 5 relating to that Schedule; and
 - (ii) if a period of less than the period of time listed in Column 4 of Table 5 relating to that Schedule has elapsed since the termination during the permitted hours of the last period of waiting by that vehicle on the same road.

- (14) Nothing in Articles (3) or (4) of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as may be necessary:-
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle to be used as part of a funeral cortege or a wedding procession;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such a purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of any local authority or with the permission of any such authority in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;

- (e) to enable the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act, 1953 or is in use in connection with servicing of telephone kiosks adjacent to that parking place;
- (f) if the vehicle is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or to wait as necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (g) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose elsewhere, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the carrying out of any roadworks or the laying, erection and alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports; or
- (h) to enable the vehicle to be used for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes.
- (15) Nothing in Article (4) of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge to exceed the maximum permitted period of stay specified in the said Articles of this Order, with the exception of the maximum periods of stay specified in Article 13.
- (16) Nothing in Articles (3) or (4) of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a parking exemption certificate to wait in any of the roads specified in the Schedules to the Order provided the certificate has been issued for the vehicle displaying it and is valid for the place where the vehicle is waiting and for both the day and time when the vehicle is waiting.
- (17) Police Only Bays
 - (a) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to stop or wait in the lengths of road specified in any Schedule listed in Column 1 of Table 6 on such days and during such hours as specified in Column 2 of Table 6 for the related Schedule provided that the vehicle is a police vehicle.

General Provisions relating to Street Parking Places

- (18) The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- (19) A driver of a vehicle shall not use a parking place so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road or so as to be a nuisance.
- (20) No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.
- (21) Where the provisions of this Order conflict with any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984 and being in effect on the date this order is made, the provisions of this order shall prevail except that any order for the provision of a disabled person's parking bay shall prevail over any provisions made under this order in so far as they affect the provision of the said disabled person's parking bay. No provision of this order shall be in derogation of a bus stop clearway marked in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

Power to Close or Suspend use of Parking Places

(22)

- (a) The Council may at any time without notice close the parking places or any part thereof.
- (b) A civil enforcement officer or any other person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever s/he considers such suspension reasonably necessary:
 - (i) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (ii) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line or apparatus, traffic sign or ticket parking meter;
 - (iii) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
 - (iv) on any occasion which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
 - for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
- (c) The Council or any person closing or suspending the use of a parking place shall place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to the suspended parking space(s) a traffic sign or traffic signs, in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002, indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
- (d) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in any part of a parking place during such period as there is over the parking ticket meter relating to the parking space(s) a hood or other cover indicating that the use of the space is suspended or during such period as there is in or adjacent to that space or adjacent to that part of the parking place a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (c) of this Article.

Provided that nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit:

- (i) a vehicle to be left in the parking space during such period if the vehicle is left within the permission of the person suspending the use of the parking place, or any part thereof, in pursuance of paragraph (a) of this Article or within the permission of a civil enforcement officer or any other person duly authorised by the Council; or
- (ii) a vehicle to wait in the parking space if being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or any vehicle subject to the conditions specified in Articles 14 (d),(e),(f) and (g) of this Order.

Restriction of Use of Vehicles at Parking Places

(23)

(a) No person shall use any vehicle while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for sale of goods or services in any other capacity or use the vehicle or any part thereof as sleeping accommodation whether by day or by night and shall not use the parking places for any purpose other than parking a vehicle.

- (b) No person shall, whilst a vehicle is in a parking place, carry out or permit to be carried out any works of construction, repair or maintenance to the vehicle or any part thereof other than may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be removed from the parking place.
- (c) No person shall do, permit or suffer to be done in a parking place anything, which may be or become a nuisance or annoyance.

Revocations

(24) Each of the Orders specified in the Schedule of Revocations to this order, are hereby revoked to the extent that their provisions have been consolidated in this Order.

Citation and Commencement

(25) This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dartford) (Provision of Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2009" and shall come into operation on the 28th day of September 2009.
