ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to 3, 3(2), 4(1) and (2) 32(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Order in the Schedule "THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (Borough of Dartford) (School Keep Clear) Order 2011" shall have effect as though -

PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS BETWEEN 8:00AM AND 9:00AM OR BETWEEN 14:30PM AND 16:00PM ON MONDAY TO FRIDAY

2. This Order may be cited as "THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (Hayes Road, Stone, Dartford) (School Keep Clear) (Amendment No 12) Order 2011" and shall come into operation on the 12th day of December 2011.

SCHEDULE (School Keep Clear)

HAYES ROAD	East side - Across the frontage of the St Mary's CE School - From a point 95 metres south of the eastern outside wall of House No.2 Hayes Road, for a distance of 89 metres in a south westerly direction to a point in line with the common boundary of No.3 and No.5 Hayes Road	Across the frontage of the St Mary's CE School
HAYES ROAD	West side - From a point with the common boundary of No.3 and No.5 Hayes Road, for a distance of 44.5 metres in a north easterly direction
