# THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DARTFORD) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS & STREET PARKING PLACES) (DARTFORD WEST) ORDER 2011

Kent County Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport given under part II of Schedule 9 of the Act and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

#### Citations, Commencement & Revocations

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dartford) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Dartford West) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2011.

- (2) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires:-
  - (a) any reference to a numbered Article or a numbered Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order;
  - (b) any reference to a numbered or lettered paragraph or sub-paragraph is a reference to the paragraph or sub-paragraph bearing that number or letter in the Article or Schedule or (in the case of a sub-paragraph) paragraph in which the reference occurs; and
  - (c) any reference to a Table, or to a numbered Table, is a reference to the Table, or to the Table bearing that number, in the Article or Schedule in which that reference occurs.
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment;
- (4) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or by or under any other enactment
- (5) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

#### General

Suspension of parking places

- 1. The Council may, by Notice or by Order, suspend the use of any parking place or any part thereof
  - a. if it is satisfied that use of that parking place should be restricted or prohibited by reason that works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road, or by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public or of serious damage to the highway, or
  - b. in order to prevent or mitigate congestion or obstruction of traffic, or danger to or from traffic, in consequence of extraordinary circumstances; or
  - c. for preventing obstruction of the streets on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination or when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed.
- 2. subject to such conditions or exceptions as they consider necessary.
- 3. A constable, or a person acting under the instructions (whether general or specific) of the chief officer of police, may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof for not more than seven days in order to prevent or mitigate congestion or obstruction of traffic, or danger to or from traffic, in consequence of extraordinary circumstances.
- 4. PROVIDED ALWAYS that any person suspending the use of a parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Article shall place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or the part thereof the use of which is suspended such traffic signs as are necessary to indicate that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.

#### Movement and removal of vehicles

- 5. When a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of or non-compliance with any of the provisions of this Order a police officer or a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place.
- 6. In case of an emergency a police officer or a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter the position of that vehicle in the parking place; or remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place to any place thought appropriate.
- 7. Any person altering the position of a vehicle in, or removing a vehicle from, a parking place by virtue of the last preceding Article of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as thought necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as thought necessary to enable its removal or alter its position, as the case may be.

Safe custody of vehicles removed from parking places

8. When a police officer or a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place by virtue of Article 44 of this Order arrangements shall be made as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle

#### Powers to change or amend errors etc.

Power to change schedule entries following geographical changes

 Where road names or property names have been changed following reclassification, renaming or renumbering, the descriptive names within this order may be changed without changing the effect of the Order.

Power to amend errors and omissions

10. Where parts of this Order (and any subsequent Amendment or Consolidation Orders) have been mis-quoted, mis-transposed, omitted or are subject to typographical errors during the compilation process, the text of the Order may be amended without changing the effect of the Order and without need for re-advertisement. The errors, omissions and other alterations covered in this item should be listed in an errata sheet and be appended to the Order.

#### Exemptions from prohibitions and restrictions

Exemption for emergency services

11. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.

Exemption for loading and unloading of goods

- 12. Nothing in this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any restricted road or in any parking place for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle, unless the effect of the restriction is:
  - a. To restrict loading or unloading, or
  - b. To provide a taxi rank
  - c. To provide a disabled persons parking place
- 13. Notwithstanding anything within paragraph (12), the driver of a vehicle waiting for the purposes of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle shall move the vehicle on the instruction of a police officer in uniform whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction.

**Exemptions for motorcycles** 

- 14. Nothing in this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a motorcycle to wait in any of the lengths of road or sides of road referred to in this Order unless the effect of the restriction is;
  - a. To restrict loading or unloading, or
  - b. To restrict waiting
  - c. To provide a loading bay or area
  - d. To provide a taxi rank
  - e. To provide a parking place for a specified class of vehicle that is not a motorcycle.
- 15. Nothing in this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a motorcycle to wait in any of the lengths of road or sides of road referred to in this Order, defined as a parking place, without the payment of a charge for parking and without time restriction.

General exemption from prohibitions and restrictions

- 16. Nothing in the Articles or Schedules of this Order restricting waiting, loading or describing parking places (save for those for specific classes of vehicle) shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any restricted road, or in any part of a parking place if the use of that parking place has not been suspended, for so long as may be necessary -
  - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load thereon or to unload therefrom personal luggage;
  - (b) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
  - (c) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
    - (i) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, of any of the said lengths of road; or
    - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near any of the said lengths or sides of road of any sewer or any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications.
  - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (e) to enable the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act, 1953;
  - (f) to enable the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to any of the said lengths or sides of road for so long as waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral
  - (g) if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being required by law to stop; or being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or in order to avoid an accident.
  - (h) to enable the vehicle to be used for a purpose authorised and described on a permit issued by the Parking Manager on behalf of the Council provided such permit is displayed on the vehicle in the appropriate position.
  - (i) to enable authorised representatives of the Borough Council to carry out effective parking management and enforcement.

Disabled persons' vehicles

17. Nothing in this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled persons vehicle (which displays correctly in the relevant position a disabled persons badge and a parking disc on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the lengths of road or sides of road referred to in this Order for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period

of waiting by the same vehicle in that length of road), unless the effect of the restriction is;

- a. To restrict loading or unloading, or
- b. To provide a loading bay or area
- c. To provide a taxi rank
- d. To provide parking for Permit holders only.

#### Lining and signing of parking bays

- 4. The limits of each parking place and the limits of any parking space shall be indicated by a road marking appropriate to the position in which a vehicle may park, as described in the Traffic Signs Regulations & General Directions 2002 and any appropriate subsequent legislation.
- The times of the restriction shall be indicated by a traffic sign appropriate to the
  position in which a vehicle may park, as described in the Traffic Signs Regulations &
  General Directions 2002 and any appropriate subsequent legislation.

#### Times of restrictions

The effect of the restriction shall operate on the days and times specified in the above table.

#### Powers to suspend parking

7. Nothing in this Article shall restrict the power of a police officer or of the Council to suspend any parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions set out in 'Suspension of parking places'.
