

DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2004

Denbighshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”) and under the Road Traffic Act 1991 as amended (whether generally or in relation to the area of the Council) (“the 1991 Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the 1991 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

PART I

GENERAL

1. (1) THIS Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of July 2004 and may be cited as “Denbighshire County Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2004.”

(2) Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Off-Street Parking Places Orders as specified in Schedule 2 are revoked on the date that this Order comes into operation.

2. (1) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order and any reference in

this Order to "Schedule 1" or "Schedule 2" is a reference to Schedule 1 or Schedule 2 contained in this Order

- (2) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"charging hours" means any period specified in column 5 of the Schedule in respect of which a charge is specified in column 7 of Schedule 1

"charge certificate" means the statement that the penalty charge has been increased by 50 per cent in accordance with paragraph 6 of schedule 6 of the 1991 Act

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000. For the purpose of this definition a badge shall be displayed on a vehicle in the relevant position as follows:-

It was issued on or after 1st April 2000 and is in the relevant position if

- (a) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or

- (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or a fascia the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in the Parking Place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the Parking Place and shall be assumed to mean unless evidence is adduced to the contrary the person registered with the Driver Vehicle Licensing Agency as the current keeper of the vehicle and in relation to a vehicle which is the subject of a hiring agreement or hire-purchase agreement includes the person in possession of the vehicle under that agreement

"parking attendant" means any officer of the Council who is authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise and control vehicles in any Parking Place and enforce the provisions of this Order pursuant to Section 63A of the 1984 Act

"parking bay" means any area of the Parking Place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle and indicated by markings on the surface of the Parking Place

"parking place" means the area of land specified by name and description in column 1 of Schedule 1 provided by the Council under the 1984 Act for use as a Parking Place

"parking ticket" means a ticket lawfully obtained from a ticket machine provided by the Council at the Parking Place for the period and at the charge and on the days respectively specified in relation to the Parking Place

"penalty charge" means a charge as stated in Article 5 of this Order as amended from time to time in compliance with the provisions of Section 74 and Schedule 3 of the 1991 Act

"PCN" means a penalty charge notice issued or served by a parking attendant pursuant to the provisions of Section 66 and Schedule 3 of the 1991 Act

"relevant position" means

(a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen a permit or parking ticket as the case may be is exhibited thereon with the front side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen so that the same is readable from the outside of the vehicle

(b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the permit or parking ticket as the case may be is exhibited in a conspicuous and readable position on the vehicle

"ticket machine" means the apparatus or device provided by the Council for the issue of parking tickets appropriately dated and time stamped such apparatus or device having been specifically

or generally approved by the National Assembly for Wales for such purpose

"buses and coaches" means Passenger Carrying Vehicles as defined in Section 117(1) of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981

"Vehicle" shall have the same meaning as

"motor vehicle" and shall have the same meaning as in Section 136(1) of the 1984 Act

"invalid carriage" shall have the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act

"motor car" shall have the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act

"motor cycle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle not being an invalid carriage with less than four wheels and the weight of which unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms and the term "motor cycle" shall be deemed to refer to the terms "solo motor cycle" and "motor cycle with side car"

"solo motor cycle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle with fewer than three wheels and the weight of which unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms

"motor cycle with side car" means a mechanically propelled vehicle not being an "invalid carriage" or a "solo motor cycle" with

less than four wheels and the weight of which unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms

“Summer months” means March 1st to October 31st each year

“Winter months” means November 1st to February 28th each year and February 29th each leap year

- (3) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if for the purposes of Section 21 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament

PART II

USE OF LAND AND PARKING PLACE

3. (1) The area of land specified by name in column 1 of Schedule 1 may be used SUBJECT TO the following provisions of this Order as a Parking Place for such classes of vehicles in such positions on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to the area in Schedule 1
- (2) Where in columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 the Parking Place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the Parking Place unless it is of the class and in the position so specified

- (3) Where within the Parking Place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a disabled person's vehicle the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking bay unless it is a disabled person's vehicle
- (4) In the case where parking bays are marked on the surface by white lines the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the Parking Place unless the vehicle is parked wholly within such a parking bay
- (5) Where within a parking place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a coach bus or mini bus the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking bay unless it is a coach, bus or mini bus
- (6) Where within a parking place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a vehicle bearing a permit issued under article 4(6) the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking bay unless it is a vehicle bearing such a permit
- (7) Where within a parking place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for motorcycles the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking bay unless it is a motorcycle

- (8) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the Parking Place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in column 6 of Schedule 1 in relation to the Parking Place and
- (9) Not later than the expiry of the parking period in respect of which the appropriate charge has been paid under Article 4(2) the driver shall remove the vehicle from the Parking Place and when a vehicle has left the Parking Place after waiting therein the driver thereof shall not within one hour after its leaving permit it to wait again in the Parking Place

PART III

PAYMENT FOR PARKING AT PARKING PLACE

4. (1) This Article applies to the Parking Places specified by name and description in column 1 of Schedule 1
- (2) Insofar as a vehicle is left in a Parking Place during the charging hours the driver thereof shall immediately on leaving the vehicle in the Parking Place pay the appropriate charge as specified in column 7 of Schedule 1
- (3) The charge referred to in the last preceding paragraph shall be payable by the insertion of an appropriate coin or coins into the

ticket machine provided being an apparatus or device approved in accordance with Section 35(3) of the 1984

- (4) If no such ticket machine as referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article is provided in any particular Parking Place specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 then the charge shall be payable to the parking attendant
- (5) Any parking ticket issued on payment of the charge referred to in paragraph (2) of this Article shall be attached and displayed in a conspicuous position to the vehicle in respect of which it was issued
- (6) The owner of a vehicle may on application to the Council purchase a permit in respect of that vehicle for such charge as shall be specified from time to time by the Council and that permit shall be valid in such parking places and subject to such conditions as are specified thereon during the period for which it is issued

PART IV

CLOSURE OF PARKING PLACES AND

SUSPENSION OF OPERATION OF ORDER

5. (1) Nothing in Article 3(1) of this Order shall restrict the power of the Council to close the Parking Place or any part thereof

- (2) Without prejudice to the provisions of Article 25(1) the Council shall be entitled to suspend any or all of the provisions of this Order on such occasions and for such periods as they shall think fit

PART V

CONTRAVENTION OF ORDER

6. (1) If a vehicle is left in a parking place during the permitted hours or in any road or length of road in contravention of any provision of this Order, a penalty charge shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed from that location.
- (2) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a Penalty Charge Notice showing the information required by section 66(3) of the Road Traffic Act 1991 may then be issued by a parking attendant in uniform in accordance with section 66(1) of the said Act.
- (3) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which the penalty charge may have been incurred, it shall be the duty of the Parking Attendant to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a Notice which shall include the following particulars:
- the grounds on which the Parking Attendant believes that the penalty charge is payable with respect to the vehicle;
 - 20. the amount of the penalty charge which is payable;
 - 21. that the penalty charge must be paid before the end of the period of 28 days beginning with the date of the notice;

22. that if the penalty charge is paid before the end of the period of 14 days beginning with the date of the Notice, the amount of the penalty charge will be reduced by the specified proportion;
 23. that if the penalty charge is not paid before the end of the 28 day period a Notice to Owner may be served by the Local Authority on the person appearing to be the owner of the vehicle; and
 24. the address to which payment of the penalty charge must be made or sent.
- (4) Payment of the penalty charge to the Council shall be either via its internet site at www.denbighshire.gov.uk or by telephone quoting a valid credit or debit card account number, or by cheque, bankers draft ,money order or postal order made payable to Denbighshire County Council which shall be delivered or sent by post to reach the Chief Cashier of the Council at the Town Hall, Wellington Road, Rhyl or in cash in person at the Council's Cash Office at the same address to arrive not later than 4.30 p.m. of the fourteenth day following the day on which the penalty charge notice was issued provided that if the said fourteenth day falls upon a day on which the said department is closed the period within which the said charge shall be paid to the Council shall be extended until 4.30 p.m. on the next full day on which the said department is open.
- (5) If the penalty charge is not paid within 28 days of the Notice to Owner, the charge may be increased by 50% on the issue of a Charge Certificate in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 6 of schedule 6 of the 1991 Act.

- (6) Continuing failure to pay may result in a judgement in the County Court against the owner to enable the Council to recover payments due.
- (7) A penalty charge notice affixed to a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 26 shall not be removed or interfered with except by or under the authority of the owner or person in charge of the vehicle or the Council.
- (8) If a vehicle is left after a penalty charge has been incurred, a parking attendant in uniform or a person acting under his direction may attach to the vehicle an immobilisation device and a notice in accordance with the requirements of section 69(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Act 1991 and that vehicle shall only be released from the device on payment of the penalty charge, or as the case may be a reduced penalty charge, along with such release fee as may be required by the Council.
- (9) Where a parking attendant has removed or caused to be removed a vehicle in accordance with paragraph (1) of this Article:-
- (a) he/she shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle;
- (a) the Council shall be entitled to recover from the person responsible such charges in respect of the removal, storage and disposal of the vehicle as it might prescribe from time to time;

(a) the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended shall apply to the disposal of any such vehicle removed by or on behalf of the Council pursuant to this Article.

PART VII

VALIDITY

7. If a court, the Department for Transport, the National Parking Adjudication Service or the Traffic Enforcement Centre declares any part of this Order to be invalid or unenforceable, such declaration shall not invalidate the remainder of the Order.

PART VII

OTHER PROVISIONS

7. The driver of a vehicle who has been given a permit in writing by or on behalf of the Council subject to such conditions as the Council think fit exempting him from any such charges or limitation of time provided that the permit is attached in a conspicuous position to the vehicle in respect of which it was issued and that the vehicle is parked in a bay reserved only for permit holders
8. The driver of a motor vehicle using a Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the Parking Place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle or to depart from the Parking Place

9. No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a Parking Place in connection with the sale of the said vehicle or any other article to persons in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services
10. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to wait in a Parking Place unless the vehicle is licensed in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 and unless there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1988
11. The driver of a motor vehicle using a Parking Place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place
12. No person shall use any part of a Parking Place or any vehicle left in a Parking Place:-
 - (a) for sleeping or camping purposes
 - (b) for cooking purposes or
 - (c) for the purposes of servicing or washing or carrying out any work of maintenance or repair to any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the Parking Place
13. Subject to the proviso hereto when a vehicle is left in a Parking Place in contravention of any of the foregoing provisions of this Order a person

authorised by the Council in that behalf may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that Parking Place and the cost to the Council of removing any vehicle from a Parking Place pursuant hereto and thereafter of making such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody thereof in accordance with Article 24 shall be rechargeable to the driver and shall be recoverable from him as a debt provided that when a vehicle is waiting in a Parking Place in contravention of the provisions of Article 3(2) and (4) a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle so that its position is in accordance with the said provisions

14. For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency a person authorised by the Council in that behalf or a police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a Parking Place or remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a Parking Place
15. No person shall except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council in that behalf drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle in a Parking Place other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this Order for the purpose of departing from the Parking Place

16. No person shall in a Parking Place wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the Parking Place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood
17. No person shall in a Parking Place use any threatening abusive or insulting language gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned
18. No person shall knowingly exhibit on any vehicle any parking ticket which has been altered defaced mutilated or added to or upon which the figures or particulars have become illegible
19. When a parking ticket has been exhibited on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 4(5) no person shall remove the parking ticket from the vehicle until the vehicle is removed from the Parking Place
20. No person shall use the Parking Place as a means of passage proceeding from one road to another road
21. Where in a Parking Place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purposes of:-
 - (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the Parking Place or
 - (b) indicating that a vehicle using the Parking Place shall proceed in a specified direction within the Parking Place

No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle:-

- (i) so that it enters the Parking Place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the Parking Place otherwise than by an exit so indicated or
 - (ii) in a direction other than that specified as the case may be
- 22. The following vehicles left in a Parking Place shall be exempt from any limitation on time and from the payment of any charge specified in Schedule 1 namely:-
 - (i) an invalid carriage
 - (ii) a vehicle issued to a disabled person by the Department of Social Security in lieu of an invalid carriage
- 23. In a Parking Place no person shall:-
 - (a) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent booth stand building or other structure without the written consent of the Council or
 - (b) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire
- 24. Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle by virtue of Article 12 may do so by towing or driving the vehicle in such manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be
- 25. When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a Parking Place by virtue

of Article 12 he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle
