DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHURTON ROAD RHYL) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING LOADING AND UNLOADING) ORDER 2005

Denbighshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) and (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and Section 43 of the Road Traffic Act 1991 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1991"), and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. (1) In this Order -

"authorised cab rank" means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.2 in Schedule 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002:

"authorised parking place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984;

"hackney carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 38(1) of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971.

"Local authority" means a County Council or County Borough Council

- (2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait load or unload at any time in the lengths of road as specified in the Schedule.
- 3. (1) Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable -
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any line or telecommunications

apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984

- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker or the National Rivers Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (e) the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of the road; or
- (f) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle -
 - (a) to wait upon an authorised parking place; or
 - (b) being a hackney carriage, to wait upon an authorised cab rank.
- The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- 5. The Rhyl Urban District Council (Traffic Regulation) (Russell Road and Adjoining Streets No. 1) Order 1968 is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to the lengths of road described in the Schedule.
- 6. This Order shall come into operation on the 31st January 2005 and may be cited as The Denbighshire County Council (Churton Road Rhyl) (Prohibition of Waiting Loading and Unloading) Order 2005

SCHEDULE LENGTHS OF ROAD AT RHYL IN THE COUNTY OF DENBIGHSHIRE NO WAITING LOADING AND UNLOADING AT ANY TIME

Churton Road:

South Westerly side;

- (i) from the projected kerbline of Russell Road for a distance of 32m in a south-easterly direction
- (ii) from a point 74m south-east of the projected kerbline of Russell Road for a distance of 39m in a south-easterly direction

North Easterly side;

- (i) from the projected kerbline of Russell Road for a distance of 30m in a south-easterly direction
- (ii) from a point 54m south-east of the projected kerbline of Russell Road for a distance of 38m in a south-easterly direction
