**(Temporary Suspension of Parking Bays) Order 2012**

Denbighshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 14 and 124 and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), as amended and of all other powers then enabling being the Traffic Authority for A542 Abbey Road / Mill Street Llangollen in the County of Denbigh hereby makes the following Temporary Traffic Order whereby the parking bays as described in the Schedule hereto shall be temporarily suspended:-

**PART I**  
**CITATION AND INTERPRETATION**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May 2012 and shall continue in force for a period of eighteen months. This Order may be cited as the Denbighshire County Council (A542 Abbey Road / Mill Street Llangollen) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Bays) Order 2012

2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"authorised agent" means the parking services contractor appointed by or duly authorised to act on behalf of the Council for the purposes of the supervision and enforcement of this Order;

"authorised officer" means the Head of Transport and Infrastructure for the Council or any other officer of the Council to be designated by the Council;

"carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a highway being a way (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles;

"civil enforcement officer" shall have the same meaning as in Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004

"driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place or on a road or length of road, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in that parking place or road or length of road;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;

“motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

“penalty charge” shall have the same meaning as in Sections 72, 77 and 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004

“The Act of 1984” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

3. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order. Any reference in this Order to a road or side of road identified in the Schedule to this Order is a reference to all those so identified

4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any Regulations or Orders made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984, or by or under any other enactment.

5. Save where the contrary is indicated, any reference in this Order to:

(a) this Order or another Order shall be construed as such a reference to this Order or, as the case may be, such other Order, as the same may have been or may from time to time be amended, varied or supplemented;

(b) a Statute or Regulation shall be construed as reference to such Statute or Regulations as the same may have been, or may from time to time be amended or re-enacted.

6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if for the purposes of Section 21 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament and the Orders temporarily varied by Article 10 were Acts of Parliament thereby temporarily varied.

## PART II SUSPENSION OF PARKING BAYS

7. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a civil enforcement officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time within the parking bays located on the length of road referred to in the Schedule hereto

## PART III PENALTY CHARGE

8. If a person contravenes any provision(s) of this Order they will be liable to pay a penalty charge

9. The penalty charge shall be paid in the manner specified on the penalty charge notice

PART IV  
AMENDMENTS

10. All traffic restrictions currently in place on the lengths of road referred to in the Schedule will be temporarily suspended for the duration of this Order

Schedule  
Lengths of Road at Llangollen in the County of Denbigh

Suspension of approximately 27.5 metre length of parking bays on A542 Abbey Road and Mill Street Llangollen. The restriction commences 11 metres west of its junction with Castle Street to a point on Mill Street 16.5 metres east of its junction with Castle Street

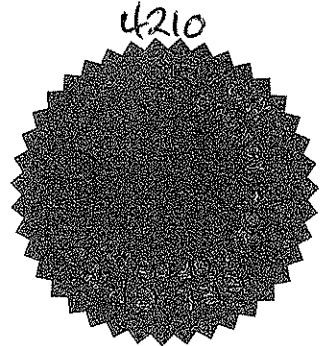

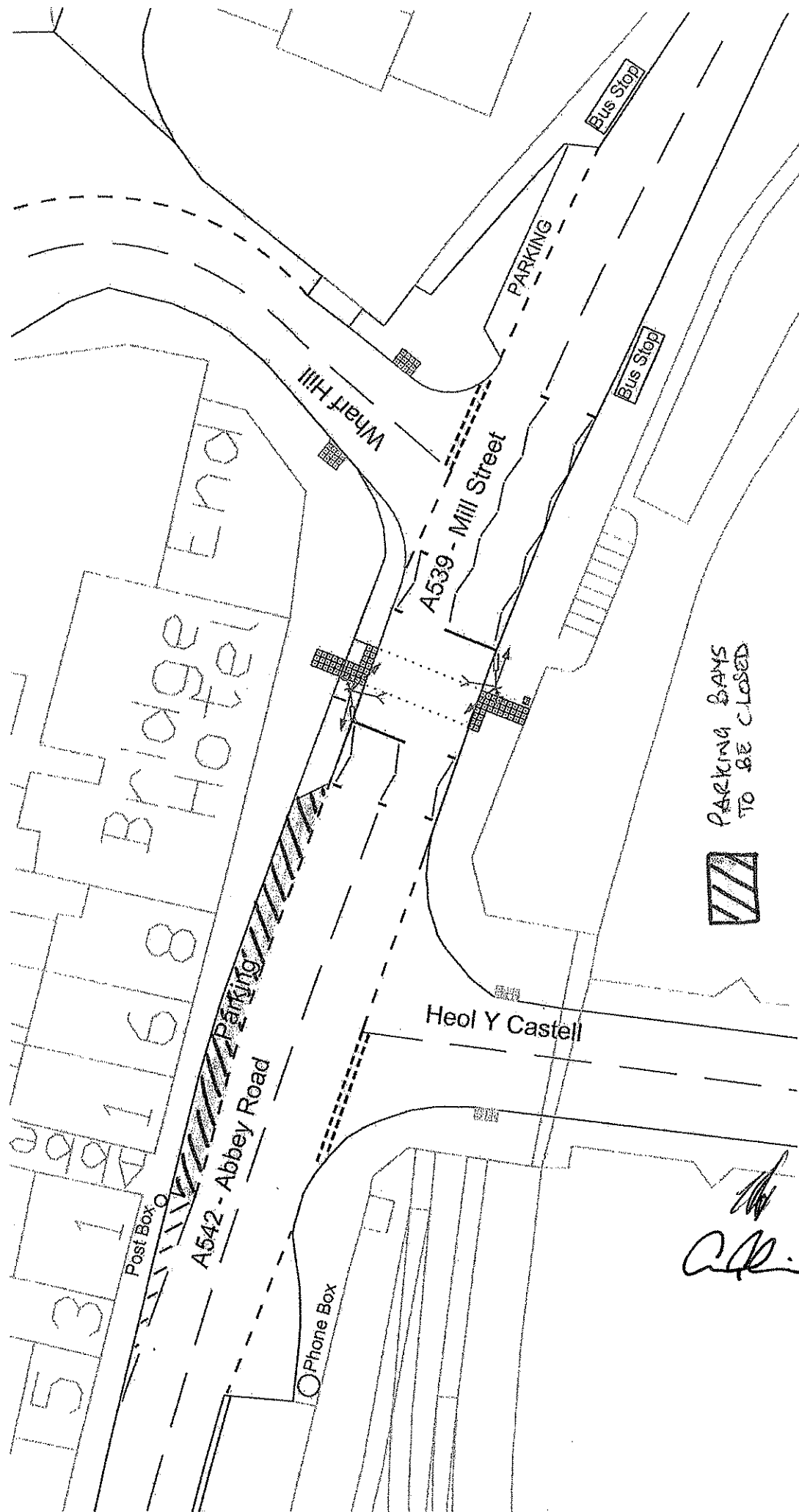
