(REVOCATION OF WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2009

The Derbyshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1 CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

This Order shall come into force for all purposes on the Sixteenth day of November 2009 and may be cited as "The Derbyshire County Council (The Triangle and Little Hallam Lane, Ilkeston) (Revocation of Waiting Restrictions) Order 2009".

2 REVOCATION OF WAITING RESTRICTIONS

- 2.1 The existing No Waiting , Monday to Saturday, 9am to 6pm Restrictions set out in the Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.
- 2.2 The Derbyshire County Council (Ilkeston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1995 is hereby amended insofar as it relates to the lengths of road within this Order.

3 MISCELLANEOUS

3.1 The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

SCHEDULE

REVOCATION OF NO WAITING MONDAY TO SATURDAY 8 AM TO 6 PM

THE TRIANGLE, ILKESTON North east side

20 metres from its junction with Little Hallam Lane in a south easterly direction.

LITTLE HALLAM LANE, ILKESTON East side

From a point 42 metres from its junction with Nottingham Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 20 metres.

LITTLE HALLAM LANE, ILKESTON South west side

From a point 30 metres from its junction with Nottingham Road in a southerly, then westerly direction for a distance of 28 metres.
