(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2012

Derbyshire County Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Constable of Derbyshire Constabulary in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of August 2012 and may be cited as the Derbyshire County Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 2012.
2. The Derbyshire County Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2010 is amended as follows:
 - 2.1 By amending the definition of "parking permit" in Article 1 to include the words "or temporary permit" after the words "resident's permit".
 - 2.2 By amending the definition of "parking permit" in Article 1 to add the words "or such other type of permit as the Council may from time to time specify.
 - 2.3 By adding the following definitions to Article 1:

"business parking permit" means a permit issued pursuant to Article 44a for the parking of a specified vehicle(s) in a specified parking place(s).

"staff parking permit" means a permit issued pursuant to Article 44b for the parking of a specified vehicle in a specified parking place or parking places

"temporary parking permit" means a permit issued pursuant to Articles 44c and 44d for the parking of a specified vehicle in a specified parking place on a specified date or dates

- 2.4 By adding the following Article 7a:

No parking shall be permitted in areas covered by this order which are not designated as areas for parking as specified by the plans and in the Schedule.

- 2.5 By deleting the current Article 13 (Permit parking bays) and replacing it with the following:

Season ticket and permit parking bays

13. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to park in a parking bay marked for season ticket or permit holders unless the vehicle is displaying a season ticket or permit valid for that time and parking bay

- 2.6 By amending Article 37 to insert the words "or season ticket" after the words "parking permit"

- 2.7 By adding the following exemptions from daily charge to Part 4, Article 42:

- (iii) Any liveried police, fire brigade or ambulance service vehicle;
- (iv) Any liveried Council vehicle carrying out authorised Council business

- 2.8 By adding the following Part 4A:

PART 4A

PERMITS

44a At the discretion of the Council any business whose premises are served by any of the car parks listed in this order may be granted a business parking permit (s) for the parking of a specified vehicle(s) in a specified parking place(s).

44b Employees of the Council whose usual place of work is at premises served by any of the car parks listed in this Order may be issued with a staff parking permit for the parking of a specified vehicle in a specified parking place.

44c At the discretion of the Council employees of the Council and contractors carrying out authorised Council business may be given a temporary permit for the parking of a specified vehicle in a specified parking place on a specified date or dates.


44d At the discretion of the Council any visitor to the Council's premises or any other person may be issued with a temporary parking permit for the parking of a specified vehicle in a specified parking place or places.


44e At the discretion of the Council any person displaying such other permit as the Council may from time to time specify may be permitted to park in a specified parking place or places.

2.9 By amending the Part 2 of the Schedule to include the following charges under the heading "Standard Charges (1)":

Any vehicle towing a trailer (including a horsebox)			
	2 hours		£3.10
	4 hours		£4.80
	All day		£7.20
Annual season ticket			£120.00
