THE DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (BOYTHORPE ROAD, CHESTERFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING (EXCEPT POLICE VEHICLES)) ORDER 2014

The Derbyshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1 CITATION

1.1 This Order shall come into operation on the Fifteenth day of September Two Thousand and Fourteen and may be cited as "The Derbyshire County Council (Boythorpe Road, Chesterfield) (Prohibition of Stopping (Except Police Vehicles)) Order 2014".

2 INTERPRETATION

In this Order:-

- 2.1 "Motor Vehicle" means any mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads.
- 2.2 "Police Vehicle" means any vehicle under 3.5 tonnes that is used by the police whilst carrying out statutory duties.
- 2.3 "Vehicle" for the purposes of this Order means a "Motor Vehicle".
- 2.4 "The 2004 Act" means Traffic Management Act 2004.

3 WAITING RESTRICTIONS

3.1 Save as provided in article 4 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any Vehicle, other than a police vehicle, to stop at any time on any day on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

4 GENERAL EXEMPTIONS

- 4.1 The controls specified in Article 3 do not apply in the respect of a Vehicle stopping;
 - a) if the person in control of the Vehicle is
 - i) required by law to stop or not to proceed;
 - ii) obliged to stop so as to avoid an accident;
 - iii) prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the person's control;
 - b) for so long as may be necessary to enable the Vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used
 - i) in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - ii) using the Vehicle for fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - iii) using the Vehicle in the service of a local authority or of a water company in pursuance of statutory duties or powers.
 - iv) in connection with the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near such road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any Electronic Communications Line;
- 4.3 The controls specified in Article 3 of this Order do not apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform.

7 EFFECT OF ORDER

7.1 The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

SCHEDULE

NO STOPPING AT ANY TIME (EXCEPT FOR POLICE VEHICLES)

Boythorpe Road, Chesterfield

East side

From a point 62 metres northwest of its junction with Summerfield Road in a south easterly direction for a distance of 7 metres.
