The Doncaster Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1 The Doncaster Borough Council (Various Roads Doncaster) (Parking Stopping Waiting and Loading Consolidation) Order 2007 shall have effect as though:-

(i) the following items were deleted from Schedule 1.01 of the Order No waiting at any time within Controlled Zone:-

PRINCEGATE

North West Side

From its junction with the south western kerbline of Wood Street in a south westerly direction for a distance of 47 metres

And the following items were substituted in lieu thereof:-

PRINCEGATE

North West Side

(i) From its junction with the south western kerbline of Wood Street in a south westerly direction for a distance of 6 metres

(ii) From a point 28 metres south west of its junction with the south western kerbline of Wood Street in a south westerly direction for a distance of 19 metres

(ii) and the following items were included in Schedule 7.01 of the Order Parking Places with Ticket Machines operating from Monday to Saturday between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.:-
