DONCASTER BOROUGH COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS DONCASTER) (PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2007 (AMENDMENT NO. 17) ORDER 2007

Notice is hereby given that on the 31st day of October 2007 the Doncaster Borough Council made an Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

The effect of the Order that will come into operation on the 5th day of November 2007 will extend the waiting and loading prohibition at any time on the north east side of Carr Lane by 4 metres and on the south west side by 27 metres.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, in connection with building industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, for the collection and delivery of postal packets and if it is a vehicle being operated on or behalf of South Yorkshire Police Road Safety Camera Partnerships while carrying out roadside monitoring or enforcement operations.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the restricted road may be examined at the offices of (i) the Strategic Director of Development, Scarborough House, Chequer Road, Doncaster between the hours of 8.45 a.m. and 4.45 p.m., Monday to Friday and (ii) The Central Library, Waterdale, Doncaster during normal opening hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within six weeks from the 31st day of October 2007 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
