DONCASTER BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2008 (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2010

Doncaster Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order: -

- The Doncaster Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008 shall have effect as though:-
- (i) the following items were included in Article 3 of the Order:-
- Where within the parking place known as the College Road Surface Car 3 (13)Park (Formerly the Irish Club) there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for "Private Parking Monday to Saturday" the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking bay unless the vehicle is displaying a current permit issued by the Beechfield Family Centre
- and the following items were included in Article 4 of the Order:-(ii)
- Without prejudice to Article 5(4) of this Order in respect of the College 4 (5)Road Surface Car Park (Formerly the Irish Club) the driver of a vehicle which displays in a relevant position a current concessionary permit issued by Beechfield Family Centre shall be exempt from any payment specified in Article 6(1) of this Order subject to the provisions of Article 19 of this Order when the vehicle is left in a parking bay available only for a vehicle displaying a current concessionary permit issued by Beechfield Family Centre and having a surface marking which indicates that the parking bay is available only for "Private Parking Monday to Saturday"
- and the following items were included in Article 5 of the Order:-(iii)
- If on the College Road Surface Car Park (Formerly the Irish Club) a 5 (4) vehicle displaying in the relevant position a current concessionary permit issued by Beechfield Family Centre is left in a parking place other than in a bay having a surface marking which indicates that the parking bay is available only for "Private Parking Monday to Saturday" then the penalty charge shall be payable by the owner of the vehicle
- This Order shall come into operation on the 26th day of July 2010 and may be cited as the "Doncaster Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008 (Amendment No.2) Order 2010".
