- 1 The Doncaster Borough Council (Various Roads Doncaster) (Parking Stopping Waiting and Loading Consolidation) Order 2008 shall have effect as though:-
- (i) the following item was deleted from in Schedule 1.01 of the Order No waiting at any time within the Controlled Zone:-

ST GEORGE GATE

South West Side

From its junction with the north western building line of Baxter Gate in a north westerly direction to its junction with the north western kerbline of St George Gate private access road

and the following items were substituted in lieu thereof:-

ST. GEORGE GATE

South West Side

- (i) From its junction with the north western building line of Baxter Gate for a distance of 38 metres in a north westerly direction.
- (ii) From a point 45 metres north west of its junction with the north western building line of Baxter Gate in a north westerly direction to its junction with the north western kerbline of St George Gate private access road.
- (ii) and the following item was included in Schedule 13.04 Loading and unloading bay Monday to Saturday 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. within Controlled Parking Zone:-

with a trade or business carried on in the vicinity
