

**DONCASTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS DONCASTER)
(PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING)(CONSOLIDATION)
ORDER 2008
(AMENDMENT NO.122) ORDER 2014**

Doncaster Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1 The Doncaster Borough Council (Various Roads Doncaster) (Parking Stopping Waiting and Loading) (Consolidation) Order 2008 shall have the effect as though:-

(i) The following items were deleted from Schedule 4.04 of the order Limited Waiting to 1 Hour with return prohibited within 3 Hours – Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm

College Road
(west to east section and north to south section)
North side

from a point 232 metres east of the north west to south east section of College Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 42 metres

(ii) The following items were deleted from Schedule 9.01 of the order Disabled Parking Places within Controlled Parking Zone – No Time Limit Any Day
