Doncaster Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1 The Doncaster Borough Council (Various Roads Doncaster) (Parking Stopping Waiting and Loading) (Consolidation) Order 2008 shall have the effect as though:-
- (i) The following items were deleted from Schedule 13.08 of the Order 24 hour loading bay with exemption for coaches at any time within the Controlled Zone:-

All that part of the north east side of ACCESS ROAD No.1 between Waterdale and College Road (west to east to north east section) situated 60 metres south west of Chequer Road which is bounded on the north east by so much of the highway as extends from a point 23 metres south east of its junction with the south eastern kerbline of Waterdale for a distance of 33 metres in a south easterly direction and which has a width throughout of 2.5 metres	Wholly within the area described in column 1	Vehicles to be loaded with or unloaded of goods in connection with a trade or business carried on in the vicinity/ a bus or coach to allow passengers to board or alight or for luggage to loaded or unloaded from vehicle

and the following item was included in Schedule 9.01 to the Order Disabled Persons Parking Bays within the Controlled Parking Zone No time limit any day

PARTS OF ROAD AUTHORISED TO BE USED AS ROAD PARKING PLACES	POSITION IN WHICH VEHICLES MAY WAIT	CLASS OF VEHICLE
All that part of the north east side of Chamber Road between Waterdale and College Road (west to east to north east section) from a point 21 metres south east of its junction with the south eastern kerbline of Waterdale for a distance of 38 metres in a south easterly direction	Wholly within one of the bays provided	Disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge.

This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of January 2015 and may be cited as the "Doncaster Borough Council (Various Roads Doncaster) (Parking Stopping Waiting and Loading) (Consolidation) Order 2008 (Amendment No. 126) Order 2014".
