

**DONCASTER BOROUGH COUNCIL  
(VARIOUS ROADS DONCASTER)  
(PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING)(CONSOLIDATION)  
ORDER 2008  
(AMENDMENT NO. 138) ORDER 2015**

Notice is hereby given that on the 14 day of October 2015 the Doncaster Borough Council made an Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984.

The effect of the Order that will come into operation on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 2015 will be to:-

- (a) change the descriptions as shown in Schedule 1 to this notice and
- (b) delete the descriptions as in schedule 2 of this notice.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, for the collection and delivery of postal packets or if it is a vehicle being operated by or on behalf of the South Yorkshire Safety Camera Partnerships while carrying out roadside monitoring or enforcement operations. The usual exceptions for disabled persons vehicles are also included in the Order

A copy of the Order and a map showing the restricted road may be examined at (i) The Council Offices, Civic Office, Waterdale, Doncaster between 8.45 a.m. and 4.45 p.m. Monday to Friday and (ii) The Central Library, Waterdale, Doncaster during normal opening hours

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within six weeks from the 14 day of October 2015 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

**SCHEDULE 1**

1 The following items were deleted from clause 2 the Definitions section

“Parking period” in Part III Residents Permit Priority Parking Areas is defined in Schedule 8 of this Order

“Residents Permit Priority Parking Scheme” means an area where any occupant of a postal address specified in Schedule 8.10 of this Order may apply for a permit to give exemption to the waiting restrictions specified in Schedule 7.04, 7.05, 8.01, 8.02, 8.03, 8.04 and 8.05 to this Order

and the following item was substituted in lieu thereof:-

“Parking period” in Part III Residents Priority Parking Scheme is defined in Schedule 8 of this Order

“Residents Priority Parking Scheme” means an area where any occupant of a postal address specified in Schedule 8.10 of this Order may apply for a permit to give exemption to the waiting restrictions specified in Schedule 7.04, 7.05, 8.01, 8.02, 8.03, 8.04 and 8.05 to this Order

and the following items were included in clause 2 the Definitions section:-

(i) "Resident & Charities Permit" means an occupant of a property with a postal address specified in Schedule 8.10 of this Order may apply for a permit to give exemption to the waiting restrictions specified in Schedule 7.04, 7.05, 8.01, 8.02, 8.03, 8.04 and 8.05 to this Order

(ii) "Landlord Permit" means a Landlord who owns and rents out property with a postal address specified in Schedule 8.10 of this Order may apply for a permit to give exemption to the waiting restrictions specified in Schedule 7.04, 7.05, 8.01, 8.02, 8.03, 8.04 and 8.05 to this Order

(iii) "Business Permit" means a Business which is operating as a business within a property with a postal address specified in Schedule 8.10 of this Order may apply for a permit to give exemption to the waiting restrictions specified in Schedule 7.04, 7.05, 8.01, 8.02, 8.03, 8.04 and 8.05 to this Order

(iv) "Carer's Permit" means an organization being, either the NHS, or registered with the Care Quality Commission or approved by the Parking Authority, to provide homecare services or healthcare visits to clients who reside in a property with a postal address specified in Schedule 8.10 of this Order may apply for a permit to give exemption to the waiting restrictions specified in Schedule 7.04, 7.05, 8.01, 8.02, 8.03, 8.04 and 8.05 to this Order

(v) "Day Permit" means an occupant of a property with a postal address specified in Schedule 8.10 of this Order may apply for day permits to give exemption to the waiting restrictions specified in Schedule 7.04, 7.05, 8.01, 8.02, 8.03, 8.04 and 8.05 to this Order for one calendar day

2 The following items were deleted from Part II of the Order:-

(i) 3 (a) (ii) at any time in any of the sides of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1.02 to this Order designated within a Residents Permit Priority Parking Scheme

(ii) 3 (b) (ii) on any day other than a Sunday between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any of the sides of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2.02 to this Order and designated within a Residents Permit Priority Parking Scheme

(iii) 3(e)(xxi) between the hours of 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday for a longer period than one hour or if a period of less than three hours has elapsed since a previous period of waiting (if any) by the same vehicle in the same length of road or sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 4.21 to this Order designated within the areas designated as Residents Priority Parking Areas

(iv) 5 (1) (viii) at any time on any of the sides of the lengths of road specified in Schedules 5.08 to this Order and within the areas designated as a Residents Permit Priority Parking Scheme

and the following items were substituted in lieu thereof:-

(i) 3 (a) (ii) at any time in any of the sides of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1.02 to this Order designated within a Residents Priority Parking Scheme

(ii) 3 (b) (ii) on any day other than a Sunday between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any of the sides of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2.02 to this Order and designated within a Residents Priority Parking Scheme

(iii) 3(e)(xxi) between the hours of 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday for a longer period than one hour or if a period of less than three hours has elapsed since a previous period of waiting (if any) by the same vehicle in the same length of road or sides of lengths of road specified in Schedule 4.21 to this Order designated within the areas designated as a Residents Priority Parking Scheme

(iv) 5 (1) (viii) at any time on any of the sides of the lengths of road specified in Schedules 5.08 to this Order and within the areas designated as a Residents Priority Parking Scheme

3 The following items were deleted from Part III of the Order:-

(i) The heading immediately prior to clause 8(1) and worded "RESIDENTS PERMIT PRIORITY PARKING SCHEMES"

(ii) 8 (3) (ii) The issue of parking permits shall be limited to a maximum of 5 permits per property the first of which shall be supplied at a cost of £5.00 for residents and £20.00 for businesses

and the following items were substituted in lieu thereof:-

(i) The heading immediately prior to clause 8(1) the words "RESIDENTS PRIORITY PARKING SCHEMES"

(ii) 8 (3) (ii) The issue of parking permits shall be limited to a maximum of 5 permits per property.

4 The following items were deleted from Part III of the Order:-

(i) The heading immediately prior to clause 8(9)(a)(i) and worded "Payment of Charge in connection with the issue of Additional Parking Permits"

(ii) 8 (9) (a) (i) There shall be a charge of £5.00 for the first additional parking permit purchased for a household or charity

and the following items were substituted in lieu thereof:-

(i) The heading immediately prior to clause 8(9)(a)(i) the words "Payment of Charge in connection with the issue of Parking Permits"

(ii) The following clause will be inserted:-
