

**DONCASTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS DONCASTER)
(PARKING, STOPPING, WAITING AND LOADING)(CONSOLIDATION)
ORDER 2008
(AMENDMENT NO.142) ORDER 2015**

Doncaster Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

The Doncaster Borough Council (Various Roads Doncaster) (Parking Stopping Waiting and Loading) (Consolidation) Order 2008 shall have the effect as though:-

(1) The following items were deleted from schedule 2.03 of the order - No Waiting Monday to Saturday 8.00 A.M to 6.00 P.M

Danum Road

East side

- (i) from its junction with the southern kerblines of Welbeck Road for a distance of 30 metres in a southerly direction
- (ii) From a point 83 metres south of its junction of the southern kerblines of Welbeck Road for a distance of 33 metres in a southerly direction.

Welbeck Road

South side

from its junction with the eastern kerblines of Danum Road for a distance of 15 metres in an easterly direction

(2) The following items were included in 1.03 No waiting at any time (Consolidation orders)

Danum Road

East Side

- (i) from a point 10 metres from its junction with the northern kerblines of Welbeck Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 28 metres in a southerly direction
- (ii) from a point of 3 metres from its projected southern kerblines of Firbeck Road for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction

Welbeck Road

Both sides

from its junction with the eastern kerblines of Danum Road for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction

2 This Order shall come into operation on the 24th day of November 2015 and may be cited as the "Doncaster Borough Council (Various Roads Doncaster) (Parking Stopping Waiting and Loading) (Consolidation) Order 2008 (Amendment No. 142) Order 2015".
