#### **Notice of Variation of On-Street Parking Charges**

Notice is hereby given that Dorset County Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") and of part IV of schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 of all other enabling powers and under Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and in compliance with the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 intends to vary 'The County of Dorset (Various Roads in the District of West Dorset) (Consolidation of Orders Made for the Regulation of Traffic) Order 2014' to introduce the changes to its onstreet parking charges which are specified below. These variations will come into force on Friday 10 February 2017.
