

**The Borough of Weymouth and Portland
(Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (as amended)
(Amendment No 21 Order 2014)**

The Council of the Borough of Weymouth and Portland (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Council of the County of Dorset in exercise of its powers of the said County Council under Section 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 35, 45-56 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), the relevant powers under Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers, in accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police and with the consent of the County Council of Dorset in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order which varies The Borough of Weymouth and Portland (Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (as amended) hereinafter called "the Principal Order". Any document referring to the Principal Order shall be construed as referring to the Principal Order as amended by this Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on Monday 24th November 2014 and may be cited as The Borough of Weymouth and Portland (Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (as amended) (Amendment No 21 Order 2014).
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. In this Order "the Principal Order" means "The Borough of Weymouth and Portland (Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (as amended)". Any document referring to the Principal Order shall be construed as referring to the Principal Order as amended by this Order.
4. The Principal Order shall be amended as follows:-
 - (1) In Schedule 1, Part 1.1 (No Waiting at Any Time), the **Amendments** detailed below are to be made under the road named below;

Radipole Lane – Under (i) (On its east side) **Insert** new (f), (g), (h) and (i) as follows;

- "(f) From a point 10 metres south of its junction with Mount Pleasant Avenue North, northwards to a point 14 metres north of that junction.
- (g) From a point 15 metres south of its junction with Manor Road, northwards to a point 15 metres north of that junction.
- (h) From a point 7 metres south of its junction with Stoborough Close, northwards to a point 15 metres north of that junction.
- (i) From a point 17.5 metres south of its junction with Creech Way, northwards to a point 17.5 metres north of that junction."

Radipole Lane – **Insert** new (iv) and (v) as follows;

- "(iv) On its west side, from a point 36.4 metres north of the extended northern kerb line of Manor Road, northwards for a distance of 45 metres.

- (v) On both sides, from its junction with Dorchester Road, south westwards for a distance of 17 metres."

(2) In Schedule 1, Part 1.1 (No Waiting at Any Time), **Insert** new as follows;

"Creech Way

- (i) On both sides, from its junction with Radipole Lane, eastwards for a distance of 10 metres."

"Manor Road

- (i) On its south side, from its junction with Radipole Lane, eastwards for a distance of 22.5 metres.
- (ii) On its north side, from its junction with Radipole Lane, eastwards for a distance of 13.5 metres."


"Mount Pleasant Avenue North

- (i) On both sides, from its junction with Radipole Lane, eastwards for a distance of 10 metres."

"Stoborough Close

- (i) On both sides, from its junction with Radipole Lane, eastwards for a distance of 8.5 metres."
