The Borough of Weymouth and Portland (Off-Street Parking Places)(Consolidation) Order 2011 (Amendment No1 Order 2014)

The Council of the Borough of Weymouth and Portland (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35, 35A, B and C and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), the relevant powers under Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, in accordance the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedures) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and after consultation with the Chief Constable of the Dorset Police and with the consent of the County Council of Dorset in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order, which will have the effect of amending the existing Borough of Weymouth and Portland (Off Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (as amended) (hereinafter called the "Principal Order"). Any document referring to the Principal Order shall be construed as referring to the Principal Order as amended by this Order.

- The Order shall come into force on Wednesday 16th July 2014 and shall be cited as the Borough of Weymouth and Portland (Off Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (Amendment No 1 Order 2014).
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Principal Order shall be amended as follows:-

In Schedule 1 (Off-Street Parking Places) Under Pavilion Forecourt Car Park **Delete** the current tariffs and conditions of use in their entireties and **Insert** new tariffs and conditions of use as follows;
