

**DOVER DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES)
(Variation No.5) ORDER 2020**

NOTICE OF MAKING

NOTICE is hereby given that Dover District Council, with the consent of Kent County Council, has made an order under Sections 32, 33, 35 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), the effect of which will:-

1. Introduce Electric Vehicle Charging Points within 2 car parks in the District, as shown in the table below:

<u>Location of Bays</u>	<u>No. of Charging Points</u>
DDC Council Offices, Whitfield*	7
(*For use by DDC/KCC EV Charging Bay permit holders only)	
Queens Road Car Park, Ash	2

2. Amend Schedule 13 (d) to list locations of EV charging bays within the district.
3. Amend Schedule 2 (20) Deal Castle Car Park,
 - (f) To introduce a 3hr maximum stay, with no return within 3hrs.
 - (g) English Heritage members must obtain a free 3hr pay and display ticket from the ticket machine and display alongside their valid English Heritage membership sticker in order to qualify for free parking within Deal Castle car park.

The order will come into force on Tuesday 4th January 2022.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within six weeks from the date on which the order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
