**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 19, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

**Revocations, Modifications and Amendments**

In this Order the expression "Order of 2005" means "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005" shall have effect as though:

**Roads in Walmer in the District of Dover**

The following entry to be inserted to the First Schedule of the Order of 2005 in the correct alphabetical sequence:-

- ARDENT AVENUE** (1) On the northwest side from its junction with North Barracks for a distance of 42 metres in a south westerly direction.
- (2) On the southeast side from a point 10 metres south of the southern boundary of 65 Ardent Avenue for a distance of 30 metres in a north easterly direction.

The following entry to be inserted to the First Schedule of the Order of 2005 in the correct alphabetical sequence:-

- NORTH BARRACKS** On the southwest side from its junction with Ardent Avenue for a distance of 5 metres in a north westerly direction.

This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No.110) Order 2023" ("this Order") and shall come into operation on the 19th day of January 2024.

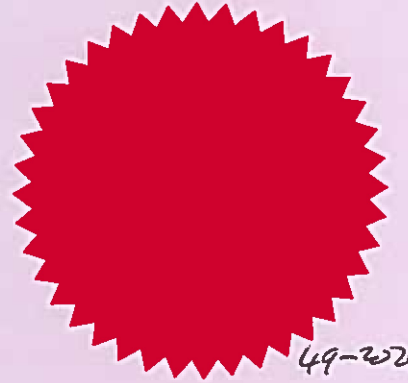
