# THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DOVER DISTRICT) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No.114) ORDER 2024

## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 19, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

# **Revocations, Modifications and Amendments**

In this Order the expression "Order of 2005" means "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2005" and shall have effect as though:

# SCHEDULE 1.00 NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

### Roads in Dover in the District of Dover

The following entry to be inserted into the First Schedule of the Order of 2005 in correct alphabetical sequence:-

CARPENTERS YARD

On both sides from its junction with Coxhill for a distance of 8 meters in a south easterly direction.

The following entry to be inserted into the First Schedule of the Order of 2005 in place of the existing entry:-

COXHILL

- (1) On southeast side
- (a) from its junction entrance to Shepherdswell Village Hall for a distance of 18 metres in a northerly direction;
- (b) from its junction entrance to Shepherdswell Village Hall with Worthington Street for a distance of 9 metres in a southerly direction.
- (c) from its junction with Carpenters Yard for a distance of 25 meters in a north easterly direction;
- (d) from its junction with Carpenters Yard for a distance of 8 meters in a south westerly direction.

This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No.114) Order 2024" ("this Order") and shall come into operation on the 19th day of April 2024.
