The Kent County Council (King Street, Sandwich) (Experimental Traffic Management) Order 2008 shall have the effect of introducing experimentally restrictions on parking in King Street, Sandwich.

NO WAITING AT ANY TIME (DOUBLE YELLOW LINES)

KING STREET	(1) On the eastern side from the junction with Short Street to the junction with The Chain
	(2) On the western side from a point in line with the common boundary of Nos 46 and 48 King Street to a point 6 metres south of the common boundary of Nos 48 and 50

1 HOUR LIMITED WAITING RESTRICTION

On the western side from a point in line with the southern flank wall of 54 King Street for a distance of 19 metres in a northerly direction

This Order will come into operation 25 February 2008 and may be cited as The Kent County Council (King Street, Sandwich) (Experimental Traffic Management) Order 2008.
