Items to be deleted

Schedule 1.00 - No Waiting at Any Time

Roads in Deal in the District of Dover

Mill Road – On both sides. From a point 60.4 metres north-east of its junction with Hamilton Road south westwards to points 34.7 metres south-west of Hamilton Road.

Items to be added

The following items to be added in the correct alphabetical sequence:

Schedule 1.00 - No Waiting at Any Time

Roads in Deal in the District of Dover

Mill Road – On the north-west side. From a point 60.4 metres north-east of its junction with Hamilton Road south westwards to a point 34.7 metres south-west of Hamilton Road.

Mill Road – On the south-east side. From the junction with Hamilton Road, for a distance of 54 metres in a north-easterly direction.

Mill Road – On the South east side. From the junction with Hamilton Road, for a distance of 142.4m in a south-westerly direction.

Access Road to the residential development on the site of former County Primary School – On both sides of the road, from the junction with Mill Road for a distance of 8 metres in a south-easterly direction.

This Order shall come into force on **26th** day of **August 2014** and may be cited as The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation (Amendment No 23) Order 2014.
