

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, DOVER DISTRICT)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION
(AMENDMENT NO 28) ORDER 2014**

The Kent County Council, in exercise of their powers and under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 44, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2005 shall have effect as though:

Items to be deleted

Schedule 1.00 – No Waiting at Any Time

Roads in Sandwich in the District of Dover

Ramsgate Road – On east side from its junction with Stonar Road, north eastwards for a distance of 15 metres.

On east side from its junction with Stonar Road, south westwards for a distance of 10 metres.

Items to be added

The following items to be added in the correct alphabetical sequence:

Schedule 1.00 – No Waiting at Any Time

Roads in Sandwich in the District of Dover

Ramsgate Road – On the eastern side of the road, from its junction with Willow bank in a northerly direction to its junction with Stonar Road.

On the eastern side of the road, from its junction with Stonar Road in a northerly direction to its junction with Monks Way.

On the western side of the road, from a point opposite the junction with Willowbank, in a northerly direction to its junction with Monks Way.

Willowbank – On the north side of the road, from its junction with Ramsgate Road for a distance of 25m in an easterly direction.

This Order shall come into force on **15th** day of **December 2014** and may be cited as The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Dover District) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation (Amendment No 28) Order 2014.
