# THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (CHESTER-LE-STREET AND BIRTLEY) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, LOADING/UNLOADING & PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION NO. 2 ORDER 2012 (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2015

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 46A, 47 & 49 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

## General

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Chester-le-Street and Birtley) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading/Unloading & Parking Places) Consolidation No. 2 Order 2012 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2015 and shall come into operation on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 2015.

# **Purpose of Amendments**

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order, however the plan(s) should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

- Waldridge Road removal of the existing School Keep Clears on Waldridge Road and replace with a shorter School Keep Clear and bus parking bay 1 hour no return 1 hour. (Plan DX169 refers).
- 2. Oakdale Terrace removal of the existing No Waiting 9am-5pm on the north side of Oakdale Terrace and introduce Permit Holders Only Mon-Sat 10am-11am & 2pm-3pm (i) between Oakdale House westwards to No. 5 Oakdale Terrace and (ii) between no's 9-20 Oakdale Terrace; and introduce Parking Mon-Sat 10am-11am and 2pm-3pm Permit holders or 1 hour No return within 3 hours. Introduction of No Waiting At Any Time from No. 5-9 Oakdale Terrace. (Plan DY170 refers).
- 3. Holmlands Park introduction on the east side a No Stopping on entrance markings Mon-Fri 8am-6pm for a length of 31.56m from its junction with Ropery Lane. Introduction on both sides from the existing No Waiting At Any Time outside No. 32 Holmlands Park in a westerly direction to its junction with Lindisfame Avenue. (Plans DZ169, DZ170 & DY170 refer).
- 4. Hopgarth Gardens Extension of the existing No Waiting At Any Time on both sides around its junction into Picktree Mews. (Plan DY172 refers).
- 5. Red Rose Terrace Introduction of No Waiting At Any Time around its junction with The Poplars. (Plan DY168 refers).
- 6. North Road Introduction of No Waiting At Any Time around its junctions with Kingsmere, Queensmere and North Lodge. (Plans DY178 and DY179 refer).

 Front Street – Amendment of the timing on the existing disabled parking bay outside Hermon House from 1 hour to 2 hours. Amendment of the existing taxi bay in part outside No. 172 will be changed to allow parking 8am-6pm, 30mins No return within 1 hour.

#### ARTICLES

# Article 2 - Interpretations

The following interpretations have been inserted:

"enforcement officer" means a uniformed police officer, police community support officer or any subsequent designation of these officers;

"loading place" means an area of highway where vehicles may be driven and parked for the purpose of being loaded or unloaded in connection with a trade or business carried on, or in the vicinity of the land, as defined by Section 161 of the Act;

Articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 8(2), 10(3) and 11(4) and 19: reference to Article 16 has been removed and reference to Article 20 has been inserted.

#### Article 12

A new Article 12 has been inserted which reads:

# **Buses Only**

- 12. (1) The area(s) of highway identified within the individual plan(s) detailed in Schedule 12 to this Order is/are hereby authorised to be used as bus/coach parking only on such days and during such hours and for such duration as may be specified within the individual plan(s) detailed in Schedule 9 to this Order.
  - (2) Each parking place identified within the individual plans detailed in Schedule 9 to this Order, authorised under paragraph (1) of this Article may be used only on such days and during such times as identified within the individual plan(s) detailed in that Schedule by buses and coaches.
  - (3) Save as provided in Article 20 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a bus or coach, to wait at any time on any of the lengths of roads, or sides of lengths of roads as identified within the individual plan(s) detailed in Schedule 9 to this Order.
  - (4) The limits of each parking place shall be indicated, by the Council, on the carriageway by the appropriate traffic signs.
