THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (B6282 WOODHOUSE LANE, BISHOP AUCKLAND) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME) ORDER 2020

WHEREAS the County Council of Durham (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") being the highway authority for the locality of Bishop Auckland are satisfied that all vehicular traffic should be prohibited on the under-mentioned length(s) of road by reason of new school construction works and to enhance pedestrian safety.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:

No person shall cause or permit any vehicular traffic to wait at any time on:

- a) B6282 Woodhouse Lane (northern side) from the eastern side of the entrance to Bishop Barrington School and westerly for a distance of 470 metres
- b) B6282 Woodhouse Lane (southern side) from opposite no 84 and westerly for a distance of 60 metres
- c) Side and rear of Woodhouse Lane (no 88)
- d) B6282 Woodhouse Lane (southern side) from opposite no 143 and westerly for a distance of 66 metres to the western side of the entrance to St Johns RC School
- e) B6282 Woodhouse Lane (southern side) for a distance of 26 metres equidistant across the exit from Bishop Auckland College
- f) B6282 Woodhouse Lane (southern side) for a distance of 26 metres equidistant across the entrance to Bishop Auckland College

This Order may be cited as the County Council of Durham (B6282 Woodhouse Lane, Bishop Auckland) (Temporary prohibition of waiting at any time) Order 2020 and shall come into force on 1st March 2020.
