

THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (FERRYHILL) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, LOADING, STOPPING & PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2011 (AMENDMENT No. 1) ORDER 2015

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

PARTI

1. General

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Ferryhill) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading, Stopping & Parking Places) Order 2011 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2015 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of September 2015.

PART III

Saving
