The County Council of Durham (Belmont, Carrville & Gilesgate) (Parking & Waiting Restrictions) Order 2013 (Amendment No 1) Order 2015 (Plan EE143).

Purpose of Amendments

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order, however the plans should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

- 1. Extend the existing No Waiting At Any Time on High Street, Belmont (which currently extends approx. 12 metres from the splitter island, opposite no 10 Broomside Lane) in a north easterly direction for 14 metres. (Plan EE143 refers).
- 2. Minor administrative amendments as required.
