

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

General

 This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Esh Winning, Esh Village, Ushaw Moor, Bearpark, New Brancepeth and Witton Gilbert) (Parking and Waiting Restrictions) Order 2013 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2018 and shall come into operation on the 20th day of December 2018

Amendments

The under-noted amendments have been made to the following Order:

Purpose of Amendments

Amends 5k/12u

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order, however the plan(s) should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

- (1) C17 Woodland Road, Bearpark remove the existing No Stopping Mon-Fri 8am-6pm on entrance markings from, opposite Cook Avenue.
- (2) C18a Whitehouse Lane, Ushaw Moor Introduce 30 minute limited waiting Mon-Sat 9am-5pm 4 mins no return within 3 hours outside of the pharmacy
- (3) C18a Whitehouse Lane, Ushaw Moor introduce no waiting at any time on the east side of Whitehouse Lane from its junction with Victoria Court to Hall Ave, Ushaw Moor; and
- (4) C18a Whitehouse Lane, Ushaw Moor introduce no waiting at any time on the west side of from its junction with Welby Drive in both directions for approx. 20m.
