

THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (DURHAM CITY SOUTH EAST) (PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2013 (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2016

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45 & 47 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

General

 This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Durham City North East) (Parking & Waiting Restrictions) Order 2013 (Amendment No. 2) Order 2016 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of May 2017.

Purpose of Amendments

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order, however the plan(s) should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

- (i) To introduce 'no waiting at any time' on High Yard from the junction with Hallgarth Street to the rear of 6 Church Street. (Plan ref DZ137 refers)
- (ii) To introduce Parking Mon-Sat 8am-6pm Permit Holders [B] or Pay at machine Display Ticket only' at a point outside no. 60 Oswald Court. (Plan ref DZ136 refers)

In so for as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.

4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
