THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (BISHOP AUCKLAND TOWN CENTRE) (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2005 (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2017

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act"); Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Part I

1. General

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Bishop Auckland Town Centre) (Traffic Management) order 2005 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2017 and shall come into operation on the 3rd day of July 2017.

3. Purpose of Amendments

ARTICLES

The following definitions have been inserted into Part I – Article 2 – Definitions

"bus" has the same meaning as in Regulation 22 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002;

"cycle" has the same meaning as defined in Section 196 of the Road Traffic Act 1972;

"enforcement officer" means a uniformed police officer, police community support officer or any subsequent designation of these officers;

"markets manager" means the person responsible for the market Traders operating with the permission of the Corporate Director of Regeneration & Local Services

"one-way street" means a highway in which vehicles are prohibited at all times from proceeding in any other than one direction.

"pedestrian zone" means the areas an highway dedicated as a pedestrian only zone on such days and during such hours as provided in Article 9 and Schedule 4 to this Order.

"universal service provider" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000

The following Articles have been inserted into Part II:

Restricted Entry – Pedestrian Zone

- Save as provided in Articles 8, 13, 14 and 15 of this order, no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle so that it shall enter the road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order in the direction of travel specified in column 2 of the said schedule at any time on any day.
- Save as provided in Articles 9 and 13 of this Order, no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle so that it shall enter the road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3 to this Order in the direction of travel specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule at any time on any day.
- Save as provided in Articles 10, 13, 14 and 15 of this order, no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle so that it shall enter the road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 4 to this Order in the direction of travel specified in column 2 of the said schedule at any time on any day.
- Save as provided in Articles 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 of this order, no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle so that it shall enter the road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 5 to this Order in the direction of travel specified in column 2 of the said schedule at any time on any day.

- Save as provided in Article 13 of this order, no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle so that it shall enter the road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 6 to this Order in the direction of travel specified in column 2 of the said schedule at any time on any day.
- Save as provided in Article 13 of this order, no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle so that it shall enter the road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 7 to this Order in the direction of travel specified in column 2 of the said schedule at any time on any day.
- Save as provided in Article 13 of this order, no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle so that it shall enter the road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 8 to this Order in the direction of travel specified in column 2 of the said schedule at any time on any day.
- 8 Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply on any day for:
 - (a) the purpose of access to premises for the purpose of loading /unloading.
 - (b) a disabled person vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge;
 - (c) a cycle as defined in Section 196 of the Road Traffic Act 1972.
- 9 Nothing in Article 2 of this order shall apply between the hours of 4.00pm to 11.00am on any day for:
 - (a) the purpose of access to premises for the purpose of loading /unloading.
 - (b) a disabled person vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge;
 - (c) a cycle as defined in Section 196 of the Road Traffic Act 1972.
 - (d) bullion vehicles
 - (e) vehicles being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets in the service of a universal service provider.
- 10 Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to:-
 - (a) registered local bus services and private hire coaches picking up/setting down passengers
- Nothing in Article 4 shall apply between the hours of 7.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. and 3.30 p.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Thursday and Saturday for vehicles requiring access to the market for the purpose of loading and unloading. Save otherwise that access between the hours specified in this Article shall be subject to the control and direction of the Market Manager.
- Nothing in Article 4 shall apply for vehicles requiring access to the Market Place for the purpose of loading and unloading or for a Special Event. Save otherwise that access in this article shall be subject to the permissions and direction of the Council's Corporate Director of Regeneration and Local Services.

- Nothing in Articles 1, 2, 3, and 4 shall apply to vehicles being used:
 - (a) for street cleansing;
 - (b) in an emergency of fire & rescue service, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (c) in the service of a local authority or a water authority in a pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) the laying, erection, alteration or maintenance in or in land adjacent to the said lengths of roads of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- Nothing in Articles 1, 3 and 4 shall apply to bullion vehicles.
- Nothing in Articles 1, 3 and 4 shall apply to vehicles being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets in the service of a universal service provider.

One Way

- 16. Save as provided in Article 17 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit to be driven any vehicle, including cycles, to proceed on the length of road specified in Schedule 9 to this Order, in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in the said Schedule.
- 17. Nothing in Article 16 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue service or ambulance purposes on emergency call.
