

# THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (LEADGATE, MEDOMSLEY, HAMSTERLEY & EBCHESTER) (PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2016 (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2017

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 & 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

### General

 This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Durham City North East) (Parking & Waiting Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2016 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2017 and shall come into operation on the 13th day of November 2017.

### **Amendments**

2. The under-noted amendments have been made to the following Order:

The County Council of Durham (Leadgate, Medomsley, Hamsterley & Ebchester) (Parking & Waiting Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2016.

## **Purpose of Amendments**

- 3. The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order, however the plan(s) should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:
  - (1) **B6310 Manor Road, Medomsley**: introduce a 30 mtr length of No Waiting At Any Time across the junction with Hunters Close (plan CT182 refers)
  - (2) **B6310 Manor Road, Medomsley** introduce a 9 mtr length of No Waiting At Any Time across the access of No. 1 (north side of road) (plan CS182 refers)

Schedule 1 within the Order described in Article 2 above referring to existing plan CT182 will be replaced with a new revision of the appropriate plan bearing a seal date as at the date of this Amendment Order.

A new plan bearing reference CS182 has been inserted into Schedule 1 of the Order described in Article 2 above bearing the seal date as at the date of this Amendment Order.

# Saving

- In so for as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
- 5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
