THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (BISHOP AUCKLAND) (PARKING AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (CONSOLIDATION NO. 1) ORDER 2014 (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2017

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act"); Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Part I

1. General

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Bishop Auckland) (Parking and Waiting Restrictions) (Consolidation No. 1) Order 2014 (Amendment No. 2) Order 2017 and shall come into operation on the 17th day of July 2017.

2. Amendments

The following amendments apply to:

3. Purpose of Amendments

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order however the plans should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

- a) Union Street replace the existing loading bay with Parking Mon-Sat 8am-6pm Max Stay 1 hour No return within 2 hours and introduce a 4m length of No Waiting At Any Time from a point at the end of the new Parking bay eastwards to the end of the Road. (Plan DL90 refers)
- Adelade Street replace the existing Parking Mon-Sat 8am-6pm Max Stay 1 hour Noreturn within 2 hours and extend the existing No Waiting At Any Time for the full length of the Road. (Plan DL91 refers)
- c) Murphy Crescent Reconfigure the alignment of the existing No Stopping Mon-Fri 8am-6pm on entrance markings to follow the curve of the highway outside St Wilfrid's RC Primary School. (Plan DJ86 refers)
- d) Fore Bondgate to Newgate Street introduce No Waiting At Any Time on Fore Bondgate from No. 35 easterly onto Newgate Street then southerly to No 40 Newgate Street. (Plan DL93 refers)

- e) Market Place introduce No Waiting At Any Time on the west side of Market Place between No's 1a and 41. (Plan DL93 refers)
- f) A688 Bypass introduce No Waiting At Any Time from a point adjacent to Bishop Auckland Football Club Ground (Heritage Park) between (and including) the roundabout serving Abraham Enterprise Park and the roundabout serving St Helens Auckland Industrial Estate. (Plans DI81, DJ81 and DJ82 refer)
- g) Ladysmith Street introduce a 30m length of No Waiting At Any Time at the junction with Etherley Lane (both sides of road). (Plan DK91 refers)
- h) Clarence Street introduce a 30m length of No Waiting At Any Time at the junction with Etherley Lane (both sides of road). (Plan DK91 refers)
- i) Escomb Road replace a 30m length of existing Permit Holder Only Parking on the south side with Parking Mon-Sat 8am-6pm Max stay 2 hours No return within 2 hours from a point where it joins the existing No Waiting/No Loading At Any Time. (Plan DL89 refers)

4. ARTICLES

A new Article 20 (9) has been inserted which reads:

(9) Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall apply to a vehicle being used on identified market days for the purpose of trading in Market Place where the vehicle clearly displays a valid Market Trader parking permit issued by the Council and distributed by the relevant Market Manager.

A new Article 14B (23) has been inserted which reads:

(23) Save as provided in Article 20 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a vehicle displaying a valid parking permit issued by the Council, to wait in a permit holder only parking place on such days and during such times as identified in the individual plans detailed in Schedule 9 to this Order.
